Pastor's Column SS Medford 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

CHARITY EMPLOYED

September 15, 2019

Friends, we are allowed over the coming weeks to offer material charity to various causes here at Saint Sylvester. This week we will have a second collection for those affected by Hurricane Dorian. Next week we will be offered the opportunity to support our Senior Priests (like Fr. Ed Kealey) at Saint Pius X Residence in Amityville.

We all witnessed in some way the devastation of Hurricane Dorian, especially in the Bahamas. The Hurricane remained near the Islands for several days destroying scores of houses, buildings, and lives. At least 50 are dead, and the number is feared to reach in the hundreds as so many are missing. One hundred percent (100%) of our collected funds will go directly to Hurricane Dorian relief efforts in the Bahamas

The Saint Pius X Residence has been a warm home for dozens of priests for decades now. It only can operate with the help of our generosity.

I visited Fr. Ed over the summer and he welcomed me into his small apartment. There he, and many other good priests who have served our Diocese well for decades, are looked after with care.

And finally, while I am on the subject of financial assistance, I wonder if we could consider being more generous in our regular collection every week? One of the things that I have noticed in my time as a priest is

that the weekly collection works out to about \$10 per person in most parishes. This amount seems lacking if we consider typical daily costs. For instance, what it costs to park your car in a public garage, stop in at your favorite coffee or ice cream store, or take the family for some simple, fast food.

Additionally, I have been looking back at our bulletins from just a decade or so ago. Then our weekly collection was double of what we see today.

I would not be writing if this was not a concern. We have minimal reserves, and if there were any substantial emergency, they could be exhausted. We also have difficulty from time to time paying our regular bills without reaching into our reserves.

Please consider increasing your regular contribution, and if your means allow, doing so substantially.

These weeks allow us to respond to our Gospel call to love God and our neighbor. Let us prayerfully consider doing so materially to the best that our means allow.


