

Gospel Teaching:

On the Gospel read during the day on Easter Sunday we hear John's version of what happened early on that day. Mary of Magdala goes to the tomb early and sees the stone has been moved. She goes back to tell the apostles the above quote. Peter and John go to the tomb and find the burial cloths, but not the body of Jesus. The last verse of today's Gospel seems to indicate some confusion when it states, "For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead." The Resurrection will become clear to them later that day when Jesus joins them as they are gathered in the room where the Last Supper was held.


Lectura del santo Evangelio Juan 20, 1-9


