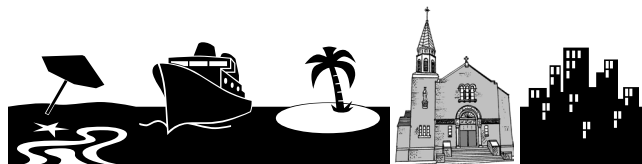
## CLEVELAND CONFERENCE OF RELIGIONS 2019 Convocation
