First Friday is this week, **January 3.** There will be the usual morning Mass at 7:30 a.m. and there will be devotions and confessions at the Mass in Polish at 5:00 p.m.

Next weekend, **January 4-5** chalk and water will be blessed for the **FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY. You may bring your own holy water containers** so that you can bless your homes and make the traditional inscription of the Three Kings (Trzech Króli).
