

SOCIAL CONCERNS PROJECT: Back to School Gift Cards for Kids

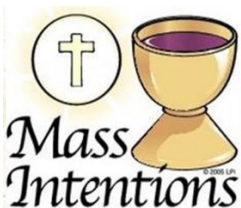
