### "YOU GOT AN ATTITUDE!"

"You got an Attitude!" is generally not spoken of as something complimentary. But our scripture readings for this 26th Sunday offer some reflection on what it should mean for all those who consider themselves to be Christians. St. Paul in his letter to the Philippians offers a text that is well received by many because it beautifully describes what our attitudes should be and how they reflect Christ.

"Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; Rather humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, Each looking out not for his own interests But also for those of others."

St. Paul equates this with the same attitude of Christ and goes on how it is exemplified in Jesus Christ. For Jesus took on his human nature and experienced what he could not have in his divine nature. While never losing the divinity, he not only humbled himself to experience human trials and troubles but went so far as to accept a cross and death. St. Paul describes this as "he emptied himself". But the emptying of his glory of being God, enabled him to become a way of exaltation for the whole of humanity. And now the name of Jesus has the same adoration as the name of God Almighty! But again this is to be reflected in the lives of Christians who empty themselves of the bloated boasting and arrogance that is so emphasized in our world today and realize that looking out for myself as number one is not my attitude. My attitude is Christ's — not my own glory but God's, not my interest but the interest of others is first!
