## JANUARY 19TH, 2020 SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**FIRST READING — (Isaiah 49: 3, 5-6)** Today's first reading is from one of the Suffering Servant Songs. These four poems usually speak of one who takes to himself the sins and suffering of the world and who vicariously heals all. Today's poem, however, emphasizes the triumph of the Servant: He is God's chosen one to bring light to all peoples.

**SECOND READING — (1 Corinthians 1: 1-3)** The key phrase in today's second reading tells us that we are called in Christ Jesus to be consecrated in holiness. The Corinthian people lived in a world which was just as immoral and sinful as our own world; yet Paul tells them of their great calling. Let us have confidence, then, that the power of God can triumph over all evil.

**GOSPEL — (John 1: 29-34)** The Gospel of John describes the triumph of Jesus at the beginning of his public life. He is empowered by the Spirit and called by the Father to be the Chosen One to deliver the world. As the Lamb of God, he will bring judgment on the world and justice for God's holy ones.

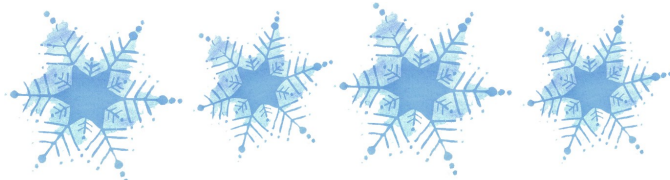
