MARCH 24, 2019 FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

Readings

First Reading: (Exodus 3: 1-8a, 13-15) Today's first reading is the story of Moses and the burning bush. God appeared to Moses and commanded him to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. Moses hesitates and objects. Nevertheless, God empowers Moses to do his mighty works.

Second Reading: (1 Corinthians 10: 1-6, 10-12) Our second reading is a warning that we must not be smug or self-satisfied. Paul observes that the Israelites had spectacular signs from God; yet they did not bear good fruit in holiness. If we fail to change our lives, our rituals and sacraments accomplish nothing.

Gospel: ((Luke 13: 1-9)) God calls us to be the light of the world and the salt of the earth. We are like trees which he plants: He expects us to grow each day and to bear good fruit. Let us pray that we may always show forth the mercy of God by our deeds of righteous living.

Pro-Life Corner

Fresh Commitment to Life...

Cardinal Justin Rigali, in the annual Mass for Life in Washington DC in 2007, commented on the Roe vs. Wade decision that legalized abortion on January 22, 1973. He called it a “misguided use of judicial power exercised in the name of the authority resting in the people of the United States of America.” He went on to say, “Each passing year confirms us in the pain of recognizing the violence inflicted upon millions and millions of unborn children and even partially born children in our land. It is important that this truth be acknowledged, that repentance be sincere, and that effective means be taken to stop this grotesque tragedy, while preventing it from being repeated in the future. At the same time each passing year confirms us in new hope for the future. As people of prayer, we are moved by the words of Saint Paul, who says: “...we have set our hope on the living God” (1 Tim 4:10). The word of God and His commandments encourage us in our efforts, and they certainly inspire the rising generation to form new attitudes and assume a fresh commitment to the cause of life.”

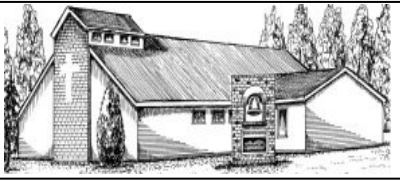

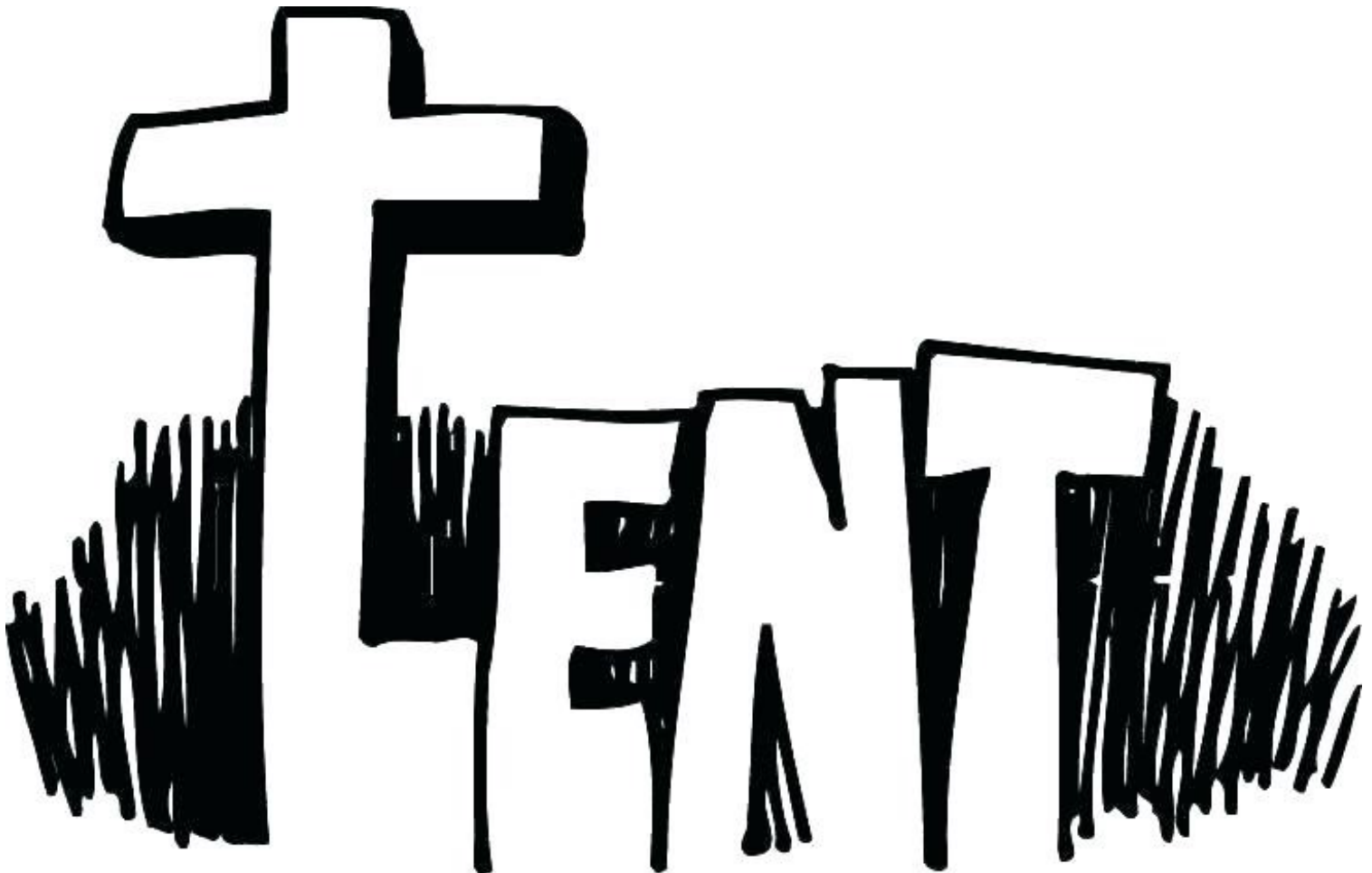
