## MARCH 31, 2019 FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

### Readings

**First Reading: (Joshua 5: 9a, 10-12)** After forty years wandering in the desert, the Israelites cross the Jordan and enter the Promised Land. The miracle of manna stops; they celebrate the first Passover in their new homeland by eating of the crops of the land.

**Second Reading: (2 Corinthians 5: 17-21)** God has made us a new creation. He has filled us with his Spirit. He has forgiven our sins, and made us members of his living Body, the Church. Let us rejoice in our dignity, and pledge that we shall live up to our high calling.

**Gospel Reading: (Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32)** The gospel today is called the Parable of the Prodigal Son; it should more properly be called the Parable of the Merciful Father. The parable gives us hope and confidence in God's mercy and forgiveness. Even when we were God's enemies, God loved us; he constantly seeks us out to forgive us, even when we do not deserve his mercy.

**Pro-Life Corner**

**Fresh Commitment to Life...**

Cardinal Justin Rigali, in the annual Mass for Life in Washington DC in 2007, commented on the Roe vs. Wade decision that legalized abortion on January 22, 1973. He called it a “misguided use of judicial power exercised in the name of the authority resting in the people of the United States of America.” He went on to say, “Each passing year confirms us in the pain of recognizing the violence inflicted upon millions and millions of unborn children and even partially born children in our land. It is important that this truth be acknowledged, that repentance be sincere, and that effective means be taken to stop this grotesque tragedy, while preventing it from being repeated in the future. At the same time each passing year confirms us in new hope for the future. As people of prayer, we are moved by the words of Saint Paul, who says: “...we have set our hope on the living God” (1 Tim 4:10). The word of God and His commandments encourage us in our efforts, and they certainly inspire the rising generation to form new attitudes and assume a fresh commitment to the cause of life.”

**An Act of Faith to Pray Daily**

Oh my God, I firmly believe that You are one God in three Divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. I believe that Your Divine Son became man and died for our sins, and that He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe these and all the truths which the Holy Catholic Church teaches, because You have revealed them, Who can neither deceive nor be deceived. **Amen**

### **St. James Basilica Tabernacle spiritual program: RETURN: How to Draw Your Child Back to the Church**

If you're Catholic and reading this, you have a friend or family member (perhaps several) who has quit going to Mass regularly, and perhaps stopped practicing the faith all together. This is the cause of heartache for so many - especially parents.

Many of us wish there was some way we could help bring about our loved one's return. Some have even tried, but don't seem to get anywhere. That was the motivation for Brandon Vogt to write the book, Return: How to Draw Your Child Back to the Church. Return is essentially the one-stop-shop for exactly what the title says, drawing your child (or other loved one) *back* to the Catholic Church.

If you're interested in learning more about Return - and what the best practices are for bringing your fallen-away loved one back to the Church - then join us at the Basilica on Monday, April 8th, at 7 PM. Joe Hendrickx will give the key points of Return (think of this as an "Evangelization 101" crash course), as well as the resources and tips on how to bring a course like this to your parish.




