

### **Pro-Life Corner** Fresh Commitment to Life...

Cardinal Justin Rigali, in the annual Mass for Life in Washington DC in 2007, commented on the Roe vs. Wade decision that legalized abortion on January 22, 1973. He called it a "misguided use of judicial power exercised in the name of the authority resting in the people of the United States of America." He went on to say, "Each passing year confirms us in the pain of recognizing the violence inflicted upon millions and millions of unborn children and even partially born children in our land. It is important that this truth be acknowledged, that repentance be sincere, and that effective means be taken to stop this grotesque tragedy, while preventing it from being repeated in the future. At the same time each passing year confirms us in new hope for the future. As people of prayer, we are moved by the words of Saint Paul, who says: "...we have set our hope on the living God" (1 Tim 4:10). The word of God and His commandments encourage us in our efforts, and they certainly inspire the rising generation to form new attitudes and assume a fresh commitment to the cause of life."

Praised be Jesus Christ. My brothers and sisters, John T. Folda, Bishop of Fargo, has given me a remarkable and humbling privilege of being appointed as pastor of St. Aloysius' and St. Vincent's. I could not image a more exciting, terrifying, and joyful turn in my vocation. I have been a priest for 20 years, I was ordained on June 3, 2000, and have tried to fulfill this vocation, to varying degrees of success as the years have passed.

However, this appointment, at this time, is clearly at the guidance of the Holy Spirit, at least for me.

I was born and raised in Harvey. My parents, H.R. and Marlys Sautner, brought me to the Church for Baptism, the other Sacraments, and for instruction and prayer along with my 12 older brothers and sisters. My father was a railroad engineer, hailing originally from Mandan. He married my mother, who was born and had her early childhood in Kathryn, later moving closer to Bismarck. I fear many of you will have the opportunity to meet some of my siblings over time as they often visit me.

I attended school in the Harvey public system until my junior year, when, prompted by the Spirit of God, I enrolled in Cardinal Muench Seminary to complete High School and college, getting my degree from NDSU in philosophy, classical languages, and music. In 1996, the Bishop of Fargo appointed me to attend the seminary in St. Louis MO, where I completed studies with an advanced degree in Sacred Theology. From this information, you may gain an insight into the most important interests in my life.

After my ordination for two years, I was assist to the pastor in Jamestown. I spent a wonderful 6 years as pastor in Lakota, where I forged some of the best friendships of my life. in 2008 Bishop appointed me as pastor of St. Philip's in Hankinson, where I lived, and moved, and had my being for 12 years. It was a place that has a great place in my heart, along with her mission parish of St. Anthony's of Fairmount.

Last November, I did make the request for reassignment, knowing that our Lord sends priests into the world not to make a home, but to point all the faithful to the eternal home of paradise in heaven. In fulfillment of this request, I was asked to accept the task, and the joyful cross, of coming here, to carry on Christ's work which Father Finnestad has faithfully performed. I wish to publicly thank Father for his gracious kindness toward me, his wisdom he has offered me, and the work he has done here. It is always the joy of a priest to know that Jesus Christ has been at work in a place before I was pastor, and He will continue to work here long after I leave.

I trust that I will have the wonderful opportunity to enter into the lives of the faithful of the parishes, as well as the communities in which they live. I beg your prayers and your kind patience with me. I am a sinful and weak man. Nevertheless, with your assistance, I will be able to draw closer to the heart of God. I thank you, most heartfully for the privilege of being here as your pastor. Father S. J. Sautner
