AUGUST 4, 2019 EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FIRST READING — (Ecclesiastes 1: 2; 2: 21-23) The third question of the old catechism was: "Why did God make me?" The answer is still true: "God made me to know him, to love him, and to serve him in order to be happy with him in this life and the next." All else is vanity. We shall never be happy unless we seek God with our whole heart.

SECOND READING — (Colossians 3: 1-5, 9-11) We are citizens of heaven because of our baptism. Therefore the earth is not our home; heaven is our true home. We must seek the values that will last for eternity, and we must avoid whatever will endanger our eternal salvation.

GOSPEL — (Luke 12: 13-21) It is foolish to seek after those things which will decay and rust. If we place our trust in material goods, or in pleasures of this world, or in any earthly treasure, we are to be pitied. We should be willing to sacrifice all things for the kingdom of God.

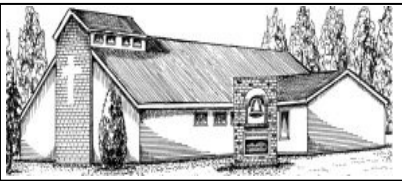
