### OCTOBER 6, 2019 TWENTY SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FIRST READING — (Habakkuk 1: 2-3; 2: 2-4) The prophet Habakkuk wondered why God's chosen people should suffer at the hands of the wicked. True, God's people were wicked; they had sinned. But why should the all-good God use the wicked to punish them? God seemed unjust. But the answer is that God permits evil only for a good purpose; God never wills evil. Through everything, the person of faith will conquer.

SECOND READING — (2 Timothy 1: 6-8, 13-14) A disciple can easily get discouraged when tragedies strike his teacher. Paul had baptized Timothy and ordained him a priest. Paul even calls Timothy his dear son in the Lord. But when Paul was shamefully treated and imprisoned, Timothy's faith weakened. Today, Paul exhorts Timothy — and us — to be strong in the faith, no matter what hardships come our way.

GOSPEL — (Luke 17: 5-10) A mustard seed is very small. Yet today Jesus tells us that if we have faith the size of a mustard seed, we could move mountains. We are weak, unprofitable servants; but the Lord is powerful. Let us renew our faith in his strength.
