OCTOBER 13, 2019 TWENTY EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FIRST READING — (2 Kings 5: 14-17) Naaman the leper was a foreigner and a pagan. He was an army general accustomed to discipline and protocol. When he asked to be cured of his leprosy, he thought that Elisha would come out to him, be impressed and then do something spectacular. Instead, the prophet asked him to wash in the dirty Jordan River. Reluctantly Naaman obeyed; because of his humble faith, he was healed.

SECOND READING — (2 Timothy 2: 8-13) If Christ has risen from the dead, our lives must be different. If he has given us every grace and blessing, he expects us to be faithful even though we may be called upon to endure hardships. If we are willing to die with him, we shall live with him. But if, by our indifferent lives, we deny him, then he will deny us.

GOSPEL INTRODUCTION — (Luke 17: 11-19) The "good news" today tells of the healing of ten lepers. But the real good news comes at the end of the story where only one person, a Samaritan, returns to thank Jesus. His humble gratitude brings about a spiritual healing as well as a bodily cure. God's people are those who hear his word and respond to it with wholehearted and humble faith.




