FIRST READING — (Wisdom 11: 22 — 12: 2) In worldly philosophies, human beings are the measure of all things. But in faith, God is the measure. The entire universe is insignificant to God. Yet he loves each person he has created.

SECOND READING—(2 Thessalonians 1: 11—2: 2) Some of the Thessalonians had given up hope that Christ would come again. Others thought that the Second Coming already had taken place. Paul corrects them both. He instructs us to be worthy of our calling by hoping and by working.

GOSPEL — (Luke 19: 1-10) Zacchaeus was a small person. But he becomes great by responding to the mercy of Christ. No sin is too great for God to forgive. No person is insignificant in his eyes.
