### FIRST READING—(Malachi 3: 19-20a)

The prophet Malachi borrowed from neighboring nations the concept of God as "the sun of justice." The neighboring peoples saw the sun as a god. Throughout Old Testament history, we see an abhorrence of comparing God to anything in his creation. Even so, this prophet takes a risk and provides a comforting image for a struggling people.

### SECOND READING —(2 Thessalonians 3: 7-12)

Saint Paul concludes his remarks to the Thessalonians with an admonition. Do not speculate about the future! Be absorbed in the present moment and your immediate duties! And do not distract fellow Christians from their own work!

**GOSPEL—(Luke 21: 5-19)** We have a psychological need for a degree of stability in our lives. We can well imagine that Jesus' hearers felt rattled when he announced the coming destruction of the Temple they were admiring. We seek to develop our trust that the Lord is with us even in the midst of events which shatter our expectations.
