DECEMBER 29, 2019 THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY, & JOSEPH

FIRST READING — (Sirach 3: 2-6, 12-14) Today's first lesson is taken from the wisdom literature of the Old Testament, yet it is strikingly modern. If each member of a family realizes his role in the family, there could be no generation gaps or communications failures. Let us listen to the wisdom of more than two thousand years.

SECOND READING — (Colossians 3: 12-21 or Colossians 3: 12-17) A child is not a parent; a father is not a mother; each member of a family has a separate and unique role to play in the sanctification of the family. St. Paul today describes the virtues which must be found in the Christian family and the distinct roles of each member of the family.

GOSPEL — (Matthew 2: 13-15, 19-23) Today's gospel is the beginning and the end of the story of the flight into Egypt. It presents things from Joseph's point of view. In the other "cycles" of gospels for this day, we have Mary's point of view and Jesus' point of view. The family of love is concerned with each member of the family.

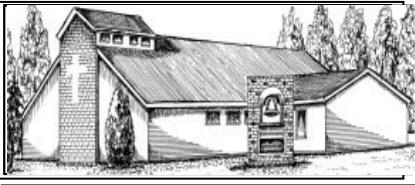
