

Scheduling Mass Intentions

There are many ways to schedule a Mass Intention: you can email <u>materchristialbany@gmail.com</u> with "Mass Intention" as the subject, call the office at (518) 489-3204, or fill out a Mass Intention Request Form. Please include the date you would like to schedule, the name(s) of your loved one(s), and who the request is from. The suggested offering is \$10 per intention. If you'd like your intention to appear in the bulletin it must be scheduled at least two weeks in advance of publication for guaranteed inclusion. Mass cards are also available. Please note that because the office is closed to visitors Mass cards must be prearranged for pickup or mailed.

CHANGES TO THE BISHOP'S APPEAL

We want to let you know about a few changes to the annual campaign formerly known as the Bishop's Appeal:

- The campaign will now be known as the *Diocesan Appeal* and themed, "For we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7)
- There will no longer be "in-pew" collection of pledges.
- The 2020-2021 Diocesan Appeal will begin with a mailing sent to parishioners from the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany (RCDA) Office of Stewardship and Development. You should expect to receive this correspondence between now and early September; it will include a pledge card and envelope.
- All pledges and payments will be sent directly to the RCDA Office of Stewardship and will no longer be processed in the parish office.
- The appeal year runs through June 30, 2021 (rather than ending in March as in the past).
- Monthly or one-time gifts by credit card can be made via secure website at <u>donate.thediocesanappeal.org</u>. You can also make a pledge at that site as well as pledge payments.

Dear Parish Family:

This coming weekend we will once again be offering our outdoor Mass, but it will move to Saturday at 4:00pm. We are thrilled to announce the return of Mass indoors at Mater Christi Church on Sundays at 9:00am. Pre-Registration is required in order to attend the INDOOR Mass. To pre-register, please call the parish office at (518) 489-3204 or send an email to <u>materchristialbany@gmail.com</u>. Pre-Registration will begin on Monday morning at 9:00 AM and end on Thursday at NOON. Please include your name, phone number, email address, and the number of people in your party. It is important that parties enter as a group if you wish to be seated together. Everyone will be seated according to diocesan social distancing guidelines. Please arrive at least 20 minutes early. There will be hand sanitizing dispensers available at the entrances. Everyone in attendance, over the age of 2, will be required to wear a face covering throughout Mass. Singing during any liturgy is still restricted to one soloist per service. If you cannot attend either Mass, you can still view the recorded version on our YouTube channel or Facebook page, and we are hoping to live-stream broadcast shortly. We are also planning to move the 4:00pm outdoor Mass inside the church beginning Saturday, October 17th. Please check our website to review detailed health & safety guidelines.

Here are some details to help you to know what to expect when it's your turn to attend Mass...

As You Arrive:

• Please wear your mask as you get out of your car. In order to maintain our tax exempt status and pastoral neutrality, please refrain from wearing any political masks.

• Bring some hand sanitizer with you for communion, and the worship aid you printed at home (if you have a printer)

• Volunteers will greet you and tell you everything you need to know about being seated

• When it's your turn, you will give your name to the volunteer, confirm the phone number we have for you, and get your seat assignment

Getting Your Seat:

- A volunteer will seat you
- Records of Mass attendance will be kept confidential; only if a case of someone testing positive at a Mass will the contact information of those seated in that person's section be shared with the County Health Department. This action is taken to contain the spread through notification & testing.
- · We unfortunately can't honor seating preferences, for obvious reasons

Communion:

• All will remain standing in their pew and Father or Deacon will bring communion to you

• Father or Deacon will drop the host into each parishioner's flat palm

• For clergy safety, please leave your mask on until Father or Deacon has moved beyond you, then pull your mask down over your chin and receive the Eucharist, replacing your mask

Exiting the Church

- Volunteers will release pews from back to front; please remain in your pew until your section is called
- If you do not make online donations, you can drop your envelope into a collection basket station as you exit.
- For sanitation reasons, please take everything that you brought with you (including any printed material, Cheerios, etc.)
- Please go directly to your car so all can avoid congregating outside and stay safe

As you might imagine, having a public Mass during a pandemic with 25% attendance is quite a production. We need volunteers to do the following before, during, and after each Mass:

- 1. Serve on the welcome team that will welcome parishioners outside the church, ensure they have masks and receive sanitizer.
- 2. Serve on the check-in team to give everyone a seat for contact tracing purposes.
- 3. Serve on the team who will seat parishioners based on their seat assignment.
- 4. Serve on the team who will disinfect the church and restroom before & after each Mass.

Are you able to help us put all the pieces in place for a safe Mass each weekend?

A lot of the people who would love to volunteer to do these tasks have a condition that puts them in a high-risk group, so they can't. We know that many hands make light work, so if you feel God calling you to participate in our return to indoor Masses, give that call some serious consideration. It's been over six months since the last time we gathered indoors...it's hard to even conceive. Until we're back to when Masses on a weekend are at 100% capacity, some of the things we've always taken for granted (sitting in our "regular" pew... attending any Mass we choose, from an array of times... coming in as big a group as we choose...) will need to be put on hold for a while yet. But we have seen New York go from being the global epicenter of the virus to one of the places with the lowest transmission rates in the country. Let us give glory to God and maintain our efforts to keep this trend going and keep each other safe.
