Dear St. Anthony Family,

I find it hard to believe that School has started. Summer is slipping by as we continue our fight against "This Virus" that has changed our lives in so many ways as we look forward to the time when our lives become, dare I say: "Normal Again". As our school begins, we pray that our staff and students remain free of any illness or injury of any kind and hope for a great year to come.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is foretelling His future as He describes His Passion, Death, and Resurrection from The Dead. Peter, who was not happy with what He was hearing, took Jesus aside to Rebuke Him saying: "God Forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you."
