"Saint of the Week" St. Rose Philippine Duchesne (1769-1852), Patron of Perseverance, Feast Day November 18th. Rose joined the Society of the Sacred Heart and when she was 49 years old, she was sent to the United States. She founded a boarding school for daughters of pioneers near St. Louis and opened the first free school west of the Mississippi. At the age of 71, she began a school for Indians, who soon came to call her "the woman who is always praying". Her biographers have also stressed her courage in frontier conditions, her single-mindedness in pursuing her dream of serving Native Americans, and her self-acceptance. Her quote: "Let's try not to be exacting with other people, but rather to pass over in silence those thousand little annoyances that tend to irritate us. For we know that no one is perfect in this life, and we must put up with the defects of others as they put up with ours."

Starting November 16-17, Scrip will be available every weekend after the Masses till Christmas. We will be ordering Scrip more frequently as well during this time. That means that we can get cards ordered on-line and special orders to you quickly. We have many cards in our inventory for late shoppers! Order forms are at the church entrances.

How many different retailers have scrip for purchase? ShopWithScrip.com has over 750 retailers to choose from and many of our local businesses work with our program. This is a great way to support local businesses as well as St. Anthony's. Local retailers are listed on the front of the Scrip order forms and lists of the retailers available on-line are at the church entrances.

How do reloads work? Some retailers use this feature to reload cards on-line that were originally purchased through Scrip. This can be done with gas cards, large retail stores and some restaurants.

What is ThankScriping Day? <u>ShopWithScrip.com</u> is offering extra bonus rebates on reloads and electronic gift cards on Thursday November 21 only.

What is the last day to place orders to receive in time for Christmas? December 15 is the cut-off date to place orders in time for Christmas.


