This program allows emergency response personnel immediate access to your home in the event of a fire or medical emergency. A key box is attached to your door and your key is locked inside that box. If an emergency occurs, fire or medical personnel can gain immediate entry without causing damage to your property. There is no cost to you. The Fire Department will provide available equipment and you supply a key. There is no subscription fee or charge.

SMOC Fuel Assistance 2020-2021—Extended to May 28th
