From the Pastors Desk

Greetings in Christ!

This weekend we celebrate the mystery of the Ascension of our Lord Jesus into heaven. The time between our Lord's Resurrection and Ascension, He appeared to the Apostles and other disciples and continued to teach them. Just prior to His Ascension, He would give the great commissioning to His Church which would soon be empowered and enlightened by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We are members of that great Church and are to share in Her work. As we anticipate celebrating Pentecost, next Sunday, we say and pray: "Come, Holy Spirit".

Congratulations to a new priest for our Diocese, Father Tim Cone. I've known Father Cone, since he was a student at USD in Vermillion. He attended St. Paul Seminary in St. Paul, MN. He, like many of our priests is not originally from this Diocese (or in my case moved with my family to California when I was age five and many years later decided to come back.) Throughout the history of our Diocese, we have been very dependent on priestly ministry from non-native sons. As we continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood for our Diocese, may those numbers include an increase in the number of young men who grew up in this Diocese. Thank you for your support for the clergy of our Diocese and seminarians.

For either parish: If you have an interest to serve the parish in the capacity of an extraordinary minister of Communion or as a Lector, please let me know. For either position, training is required and done by me. Besides training, there are some other qualifications to be met. To be an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, one must be a faithful, practicing Confirmed Catholic and this includes living in accord morally with the Commandments as the Church has always traditionally taught. In this day and age, it is necessary to mention this includes no cohabitation with someone who is not your spouse according to the precepts and teaching of the Church. To qualify as a Lector, since it too it such a public ministry, the same moral expectations hold as with an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. A young person, who is a faithful, practicing Catholic, but not yet Confirmed would be able to be a Lector. Obviously, for such a liturgical role, one must be a good reader and be able to pronounce words clearly. If you have an interest in either liturgical role, please contact me (Fr. Rader) within the next couple of weeks, so I can set up training sessions at each parish. Thank you.
