

### Dominic's Den

On May 14, 1217, Pentecost, Dominic gathered his 16 friars at Prouille and told them of his intention to scatter them and send them throughout the world. Many of the brethren were surprised by the announcement and objected, but Dominic said, "Do not object to this, for I know what I am doing. The world henceforth is your home, and the work God has ordained for you is preaching and teaching. Go ye, therefore into the world and teach all na-

fore, into the world and teach all nations. Preach to them the glad tidings of their redemption. Have confidence in God, for the field of your labors will one day widen to the uttermost ends of the earth." The actual dispersal of the brethren took place on August 15, 1217, without money or provisions. They were sent to Paris, Spain, Rome, and Bologna, chiefly to cities and university towns, where the friars could study, engage with new ideas, and recruit new friars. By the time of Dominic's death, 500 friars were settled as far as Hungary, Denmark, and England. By the end of the 13th century, there were 404 priories and almost 15,000 friars including a province in the Holy Land.
