Sacrament of Reconciliation see schedule below for weekday confessions, or by appointment


Sacrament of Baptism - Call Father to set up a date, preferably before the birth of the child.

I am convinced that this pandemic is a mysterious gift from God meant to call us to conversion. In the book of Hebrews we read, "the Lord disciplines him whom he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline?" We should see this pandemic as God, as a good Father, disciplining us and reminding us what is truly important, namely the reverent worship of God, the reception of the Sacraments, prayer - especially family prayer, love of family, and love of neighbor. During this time let us receive Gods discipline, let us reorder our lives so that when God removed those chastisement from us we will be holier.

Let us remember each other in prayer, especially the Holy Rosary. Know that I pray for all of you. Please pray for me, especially during this time of transition.

CFSA Update:


St Mary of Mercy-Alexandria has reached \$14,430.00 of \$18,000.00 which is 49% with 69 of 140 households responding.
