+++<u>*Ushers....*</u> will take up the collection. We will have the children's collection. The little ones may bring their gift to the priest right after the intercessions beginning next weekend. Ushers, please give them a little time before you begin the collection. Once the collection is taken up, ushers, I ask you <u>together</u> put all items gathered into a security bag that can be sealed and that you then bring to the sanctuary....so important for protection of money; even more important for the paper trail for ushers and money counters against accusations. Your ministry is important to us.



++<u>A Sign of Peace.....</u>as I have these past 2 weekends to acknowledge some sign of awareness & peace to those around you. For some it may be a smile, thumbs up, a handshake, a nod, what is comfortable for each.
