I know that it is not easy to go to Confession. To be honest, I still struggle to go even as a priest. Yet, I know that I need regular encounters with Jesus' merciful heart in the Sacrament of Confession. So, I take courage and go. I always feel so free and joyful after I've gone to Confession.

Receiving the Lord's forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a wonderful opportunity to open your heart to receive more of God's love at Christmas. God has so much love in store

for each of us. But our sin prevents us from receiving the fullness of that love. Confession allows us to open wide our hearts so God can pour all his love into us, right where we need it most. Sometimes people tell me they don't know what they would confess in the Reconciliation. The good news is that there are so many amazing resources out there to help. You can easily find different examinations of conscience online that will help you look at your life and give you a language for the sins you might want to confess. If it has been a while, the priest will guide you through what to do and the prayers to say.

Remember, Confession is a sacrament of healing. I know sometimes it is hard to go to the doctor, but it is better than dying. Confession works the same way. It is not always easy to go but it is better than living with a dead heart, separated from God's grace. I offer Confession every single week on Tuesdays from 5:00pm –5:50pm. I will be offering a special hour of Confession this Sunday from 3:45pm-4:45pm. And if you ever want to go to Confession outside scheduled times, just tell me and I will make it happen. Let's finish this last half of Advent strong, rooted in God's loving mercy!
