Announcing the publication of *Wyoming's Padre: a Cowboy Catholic Priest*- a book containing excerpts from the life and words of Wyoming native son Father Carl Beavers

Carl Beavers believed that if you were lucky enough to be born in Wyoming, you had to give back according to the gifts God gave you. He did that by serving the Diocese of Cheyenne as a most beloved priest for over 50 years. His gifts were considerable. He brought intelligence, common sense and wit to all he said and did. Combined with boundless energy and deep faith, this made him both memorable and inspirational.

Fr. Beavers believed that some of the best people in the world lived in Wyoming and that he was lucky to call some of them friends. Counted among those friends were governors, senators, business leaders, and politicians, as well as students, orphans, migrants, fisherman, hunters, farmers, scholars and fellow seekers of the will of God from all faiths.

One of those friends, former Governor Mike Sullivan, recalls, "Fr. Beavers was without peer in his ability to craft prayers, homilies and formal presentations. He did so with clarity of thought articulated in a voice for the ages. "Former parishioner Bill Sawczuk saw Fr. Beavers' legacy to be not only in what he said, but also in what he did- preach always and when necessary use words. "His life was a devotion to the people of Wyoming, building up God's people in parishes and communities through his willingness and readiness to help anywhere."

Fr. Beavers' sudden death, July 23, 2020, compelled the writing of this book. The hope is that you will be inspired by his service to our great state, his wisdom and his dedication to the Lord to go out and do your part.

Wyoming's Padre is available on Kindle and Amazon. All proceeds go to three of Father's favorite charities: St. Joseph's Children's Home and Diocesan funds for seminarians and retired priests.
