Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

All of you are children of the light and children of the day.
We are not of the night or of darkness.
Therefore, let us not sleep as the rest do,
but let us stay alert and sober.

1 Thessalonians 5:5-6

THE REST OF THE STORY

Paul Harvey was a popular radio broadcaster with a daily program during which he would relate a historical anecdote, but it would have a twist at the end, and then he would intone “and now you know the rest of the story.” Our scriptures today are like that. We await the coming Christ as the readings describe for us how to be good servants, but they give us a limited picture. The famous Proverbs passage, “The Valiant Wife” is edited down from the full selection (31:10–31) to just a few verses. Take a couple moments to explore the fuller selection. Psalm 128 proclaims, “Blessed are those who fear the Lord,” but in this context “fear” doesn’t mean dread and trepidation. Rather, this kind of fear means “to show awe,” and there are wonderful promises made to those who do. The letter to the Thessalonians continues the call to be alert, and Matthew shows us various ways that people might respond to God in the parable of the talents. The Gospel is presented in long and shortened versions; be sure to read the whole thing so you can get “the rest of the story.”

REMAIN IN ME

In the story of the talents, the head of the household leaves the servants “talents” or money, which they are expected to foster and develop during the leader’s absence. Today we think of talent as an innate ability or a skill. It is interesting that they were distributed “according to ability,” which would express a certain intimacy as we realize that the master knew each one, and already had an idea of their capabilities. They were not given explicit instructions like “put this in the bank” or “invest this in your portfolio” or “take piano lessons.” Rather, we are told that the goods were divided unequally. One received five, one received two, and the last received one.

BEAR MUCH FRUIT

When the head of the household returned, the outcomes were just as varied as we and our responses might be. Some people are multitalented, and capable of accomplishing many great things, like the servant who turned five into ten. Others may be more inclined to do one or two things very well and may excel in them. Still, there are some who may struggle in life, and their accomplishments are very small. But those who made use of their gifts were praised and told, “Well done, good and faithful servant.” When it came to the second coming, the return of their master, they both made some effort. The only one in whom the head of household showed any disappointment was the one who made absolutely no effort, the one who was frozen by fear or indifference. As we journey toward the kingdom, there are not always clear instructions. We are simply asked to try, to give it our best effort. There is nothing in the passage to say that these servants didn’t make mistakes along the way, but their master saw them and loved and praised them for their actions, their attempts, as God will do with us. And now you know the rest of the story.

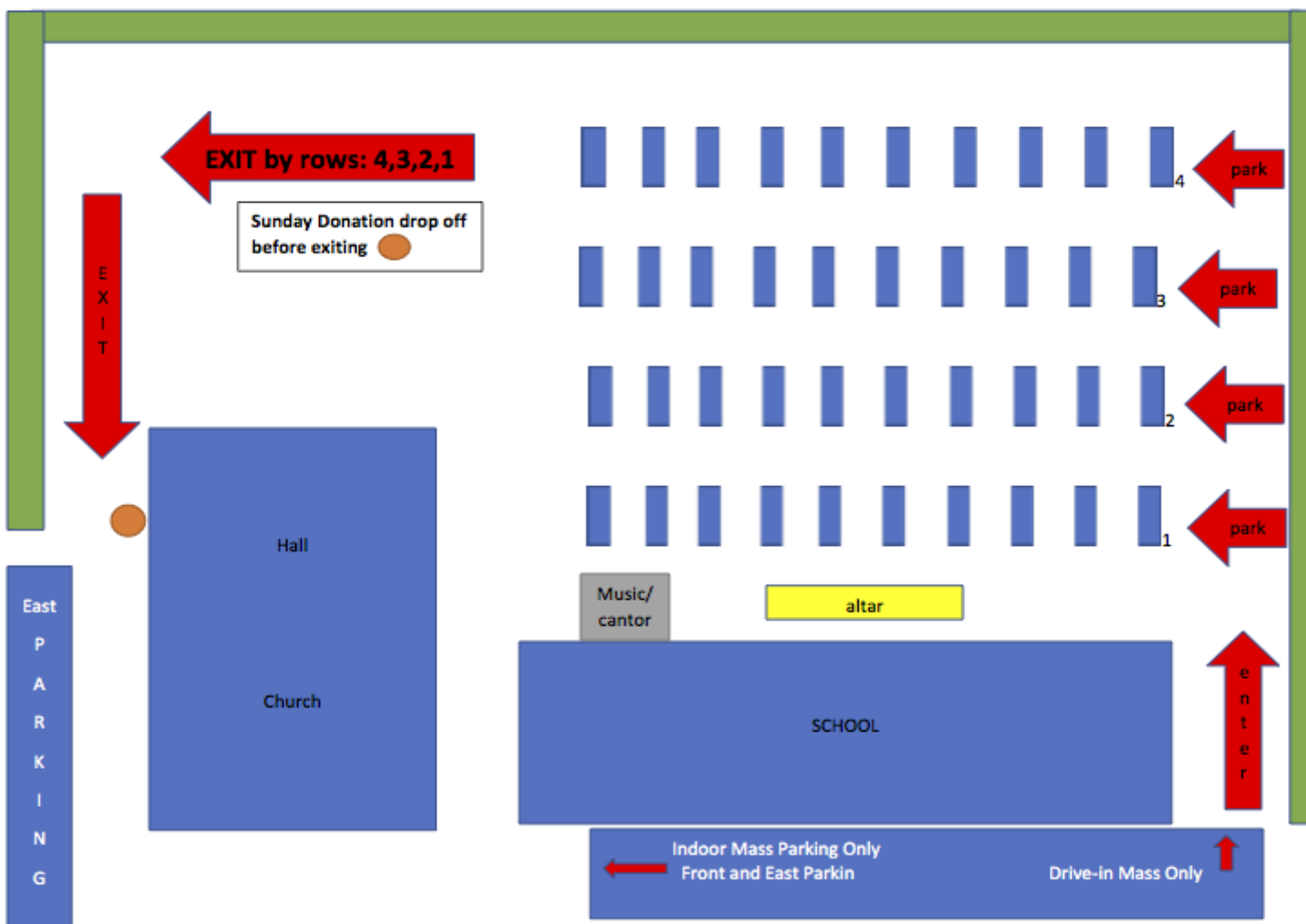

Drive-in Mass Etiquette and Procedure

- ⇒ **Observe proper dress codes when attending drive-in Mass**
- ⇒ **Arrive at least 15 minutes before mass begins**
 - Gates will be closed once mass starts to avoid distraction
 - Be on time
- ⇒ **Follow traffic flow and directions**
 - Park by rows beginning from Row 1,2,3,4
- ⇒ **All vehicles must be facing one direction as in a drive-in format facing the worship area**
- ⇒ **Park at the marked lot only (X mark)**
- ⇒ **Once parked**
 - Tune in **FM 101.9** for audio
 - * *No outdoor speakers set up for drive-in mass*
 - Do not leave car – no restroom access
 - Roll window down if desired
 - Turn off engine
 - Avoid chatting with neighboring vehicles

Drive-in Mass Etiquette and Procedure
 (continued)

- ⇒ **Respond at Mass parts as usual**
- ⇒ **Communion**
 - Stay inside your car
 - Turn on car Hazard flasher if you desire to receive communion
 - Lower windows
 - Wear mask; sanitize hands before receiving communion
 - Turn off Hazard flasher after receiving communion
 - Only ministers will hand communion to everyone inside the car
 - Flow of communion
 - * *Driver's side first – front to back*
 - * *Passenger's side – back to front*
 - Do not leave/drive off after receiving communion
 - * *Exit gates will be opened only at dismissal*
- ⇒ **After final blessing**
 - * *Follow instructions to exit*
 - * *Row 4, 3, 2, 1*
 - * *Drop your donation at the basket by the exit gate*
- ⇒ **Drive safe home**

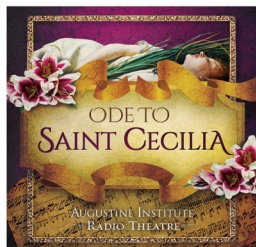
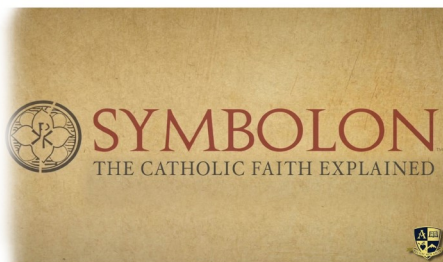

St. Victor Church Indoor Church Celebrations

Effective October 14, 2020

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- ⇒ Dispensation for Sunday Obligation is still granted until further notice.
 - ⇒ People who are in high-risk categories should refrain from attending public worship, parish activities, or coming to the church for private prayer and devotion, including
 - Persons over the age of 65;
 - Persons with underlying health issues or compromised immune systems
 - ⇒ Persons who have been exposed to COVID-19 should not attend Mass or other parish gatherings.
 - ⇒ People who are ill should refrain from attending public worship, parish activities, or coming to the church for private prayer and devotion, including
 - People with a cough or who are sneezing;
 - People who are feeling ill
 - ⇒ Temperature check will be done before entry.
 - ⇒ Social distancing is strictly observed.
 - ⇒ Wear mask at all times and sanitize/wash hands frequently.
- ⇒ Avoid handshaking and/or hugging
We can wave to say Hi !
 - ⇒ Use designated entrance and exit only
 - ⇒ Gathering at parking lots or within the church area after service is discouraged
 - ⇒ When using the restroom, observe proper decorum by cleaning/sanitizing for next use

HOLY EUCHARIST

For Mass in Physical Attendance:

◆ ATTENDANCE

- ALL attending must be in good health condition
- Please arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled mass
- Limited seating capacity (100 people inside the church)
 - * Reservation is required for ALL masses.
 - * Call the parish office OR reserve on line at <http://bit.ly/attendmass>.
 - ◇ One reservation for each attendee (all members of the same household attending the mass must each have a reservation. The same email address may be used.)
 - * Those living in the same household to stay together
- Wear mask
- Sanitize before entering and exiting. (sanitizers provided)

◆ COMMUNION

- Receive communion reverently only by hands
- Observe social distancing while on queue for communion (please follow directions)
- Sanitize before receiving communion (sanitizers provided at the communion stations.)
- Stay until the final blessing and dismissal

◆ DISMISSAL

- Sanitize hands before exiting
- NO Bulletin hand out – all bulletin contents will be available online

***Upon reaching your respective houses, please do not forget to wash your hands before doing anything.

- For those who must shelter at home:
 - * You may designate a family member who will be attending in-person mass to get communion for you using a pyx. (pyx can be bought online or other religious stores)

St. Victor Etiquette in Participating Live Stream Eucharistic Celebrations (COVID-19 adaptations)

- Prepare as if you are going to Mass physically
 - ◇ Wear a decent clothing
 - ◇ Designate a prayer room (free from phone ringing, animal noise, or other distractions)
 - ◇ Invite family members to participate
 - ◇ Be still and be quiet
 - ◇ Respond to all parts of the mass (you may be on mute, I hope that you still respond)
- Download the zoom application or go to <https://zoom.us/>. On the upper right screen click join meeting enter meeting ID when prompted click join. There is no password required.
- Upon logging in, make sure that
 - ◇ You mute your zoom screen (not device as this will turn off your audio
 - ◇ Your Video can either be turned ON or OFF
 - * you should be able to see and hear the presider as well as the lector.
- During Communion, the presider will ask you to recite a Spiritual Communion Prayer:
*My Jesus,
I believe that You
are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things,
and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment
receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there
and unite myself wholly to You.
Never permit me to be separated from You.
Amen.*
- After Mass, take about 5 minutes to be with your family in that designated prayer room and talk about the Readings and or the Homily.
