called the “Great Lord’s Day”. Each Sunday of the season is
treated as a Sunday of Easter...The first eight days constitute
the Octave of Easter and are celebrated as Solemnities of the

items from your Spring cleaning activities.



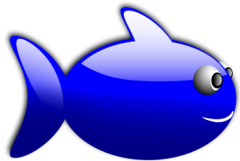

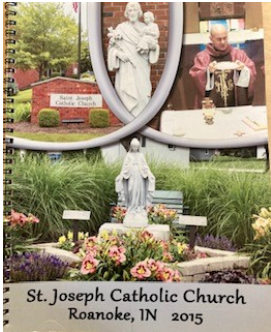
