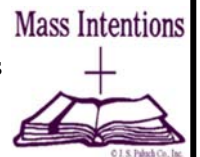

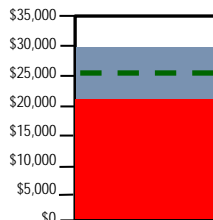

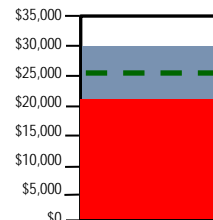

Follow the Rosary to treasure

The Rosary is like an ancient treasure map. It has led countless faithful to the treasures of peace, joy, clarity, and contentment. If you follow where it leads, you'll find that a devotion to praying the Rosary can transform your life.

Shelter in a chaotic world. Leading hectic lives can fog the mind, unsettle the soul, and turn us away from God. Yet, our souls are made for peace. Praying the Rosary settles our thoughts. It puts us at ease, creating a peace that is otherworldly.



Perspective. Humans are constantly changing, thus our relationship with God changes. The Rosary provides the context, the format, and the process for God to speak to us about all these things.

Mary's blessing. Nobody sees the life of a child the way that child's mother does. Our Lady has a mother's perspective of Jesus' life. Learning and sharing that perspective helps us ponder the life of Jesus through the eyes of his Mother. This is a powerful experience if we enter into it fully.

from Scripture

Luke 18:9-14, God wants only love

In this Gospel passage, Jesus compared the prayers of a proud Pharisee and a humble tax collector – which probably scandalized his audience. Pharisees were considered the model for faithful Jews, while tax collectors, who worked for the Romans (and stole a little extra money on the side), were considered traitors by their fellow Jews.

The Pharisee marched up to a position of honor in the temple to pray, presumably to be seen and admired. His prayer wasn't really a prayer of

thanksgiving, but self-praise. By contrast, the tax collector humbled himself before God and offered only a simple prayer casting himself on God's mercy. He went home justified.

Promoting oneself in prayer is unnecessary: God already knows and loves us, and he wants us to love him in return. When you love someone, you'd never do anything to hurt them, and if you

did, you'd apologize right away and try to fix it. With God, we have to call on his grace and mercy to make amends. In the end, our love counts for more than anything else we do.



Q & A Why should I read the Bible?

The Bible is the world's longest love letter. As part of the deposit of faith, it's a



treasure-trove of our inheritance as children of God. Here are three benefits of reading Scripture:

We encounter God. We not only learn about God from the Bible, but we actually encounter him in our hearts when we pray with Scripture. "In the sacred books, the Father who is in heaven comes lovingly to meet his children, and talks with them" (CCC, #104).

Packed with sound advice. Books like Sirach, Proverbs, and Wisdom have practical advice on how to virtuously handle relationships, home life, business, and dealing with difficult people. If we want to know what this looks like in action, the Gospels give us Christ's teaching and example.

It is a "roadmap" to heaven. Like a map, Scripture outlines what we need to know about God and his saving plan. The Magisterium, who interprets the Scriptures under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, holds the "key" to reading the "map" (CCC, #100).

Feasts & Celebrations

Oct. 7 - Our Lady of the Rosary (1571). Pope Gregory XIII named this feast because it was believed that Christians won a critical victory at the Battle of Lepanto after praying the Rosary.

Oct. 15 - St. Teresa of Ávila (1582). Teresa joined the Carmelites, against her father's wishes. In 1563, she was inspired to reform her order. Despite serious opposition, she founded more than 17 convents of Discalced Carmelites and helped reform the Carmelite friars.

October 17 - St. Ignatius of Antioch (d.c. 107). Successor to

St. Peter as Bishop of Antioch, Ignatius was sentenced to death for his faith. On route to Rome, he wrote letters, encouraging his fellow Christians to remain faithful.

Oct. 28 - SS. Simon and Jude (1st Century). St. Simon was a Zealot – Jews who believed that the Messiah would free them from political oppression. St. Jude was a fisherman. After being called by Jesus to be apostles, they eventually traveled to Persia where they preached the Gospel until they were martyred.

Siga el Rosario hasta el tesoro

El Rosario es como un antiguo mapa del tesoro. júbilo, claridad y alegría. Si lo sigue a donde conduce, descubrirá que la devoción del rezo del Rosario puede transformar su vida.

Refugio en un mundo caótico. Las ajetreadas vidas que vivimos pueden enturbiar nuestra mente, perturbar el espíritu y alejarnos de Dios. Pero nuestras almas están hechas para la paz. Rezar el Rosario ordena nuestros pensamientos. Nos tranquiliza, creando una paz que no es de este mundo.

Perspectiva. Los seres humanos cambian



constantemente y, por lo tanto, cambia nuestra relación con Dios. El Rosario proporciona el contexto, el formato y el proceso para que Dios nos hable sobre todo eso.

La bendición de María. Nadie ve la vida de un hijo como la ve la madre de ese hijo. Nuestra Señora tiene perspectiva de madre sobre la vida de Jesús. Aprender y compartir esa perspectiva nos ayuda a pensar detenidamente en la vida de Jesús a través de los ojos de su madre. Es una experiencia potente si nos entregamos a ella por completo.

de las **E**scrituras

Lucas 18-9-14, Dios sólo quiere amor

En este pasaje del Evangelio, Jesús comparó las oraciones de un fariseo orgulloso y las de un humilde recaudador de impuestos y posiblemente escandalizó a su audiencia. Se pensaba que los fariseos eran un ejemplo para los judíos de fe, mientras que los recaudadores de impuestos, que trabajaban para los romanos (y robaban un poco de dinero de lo que recaudaban), eran considerados traidores por sus compatriotas judíos.

Los fariseos ocupaban una posición de honor en el templo para rezar, posiblemente para que los vieran y admiraran. Su oración no era de agradecimiento sino de

autocomplacencia. En contraste, el recaudador de impuestos rezaba a Dios con humildad y ofrecía una sencilla oración suplicando la misericordia de Dios. Regresaba a casa excusado.

Alabarse a uno mismo en la oración es innecesario: Dios nos conoce y nos ama y quiere que correspondamos a su amor. Cuando amamos a alguien, procuramos no hacerle

daño y, si lo hacemos, pedimos perdón inmediatamente y procuramos enmendarlo. En el caso de Dios tenemos que pedirle su gracia y su misericordia para reparar el daño. Al final, nuestro amor vale más que cualquier otra cosa que hagamos.



P & R ¿Por qué debo leer la Biblia?

La Biblia es la carta de amor más larga del mundo. Como parte del depósito de nuestra fe, es un tesoro oculto de nuestro patrimonio como hijos de Dios. He aquí Escritura: **Nos encontramos con Dios.** No solo conocemos a Dios en la Biblia, sino que además lo encontramos en nuestros corazones cuando rezamos con la Escritura. "En los libros sagrados, el Padre que está en el cielo sale amorosamente al encuentro de sus hijos para conversar con ellos" (CIC, #104).



Está llena de buenos consejos. Libros como Eclesiástico, Proverbios o Sabiduría contienen consejos prácticos para gestionar las relaciones de forma sana, sobre la vida doméstica, los negocios y el trato con gente difícil. Si queremos saber qué hacer, los Evangelios nos proporcionan las enseñanzas y el ejemplo de Cristo.

Es una "hoja de ruta" hacia el cielo. Lo mismo que un mapa, la Escritura esboza lo que tenemos que saber sobre Dios y su plan de salvación. El magisterio de la Iglesia, que interpreta las Escrituras bajo la dirección del Espíritu Santo, posee la "clave" para leer el "mapa" (CIC, #100).

Fiestas y celebraciones

7 de octubre - Nuestra Señora del Rosario (1571). El papa Gregorio XIII los cristianos ganaron la batalla de Lepanto después de rezar el Rosario.

15 de octubre - Santa Teresa de Ávila (1582). Teresa ingresó en las carmelitas contra los deseos de su padre. En 1563 sintió la inspiración de reformar la orden. A pesar de la oposición a la que se enfrentó, fundó más de 17 conventos de carmelitas descalzas y ayudó a reformar a los frailes carmelitas.

17 de octubre - San Ignacio de

Antioquía (siglo I). Sucesor de san Pedro como obispo de Antioquía, Ignacio fue sentenciado a muerte por su fe. En el camino a Roma escribió cartas, animando a los cristianos a permanecer en la fe.

28 de octubre - Santos Simón y Judas (siglo I). San Simón pertenecía a los zelotes, un grupo de judíos que creía que el mesías los liberaría de la opresión política. San Judas era pescador. Al llamarlos Jesús para que fueran apóstoles, viajaron hasta Persia donde predicaron el evangelio hasta ser martirizados.
