#### Dear Parishioner:

A week and a half ago we had a meeting and a meal on the pergola for our monthly Grief Support Group. It was a truly blessed meeting and meal in that it was the largest gathering of the group in 3 or 4 years, and in that the sun



seemed to break through the clouds and the humidity took a break just as we were meeting, and finally in that the spirit of the meeting was yet another "installment" of the spirit that has been present in the group for quite some time now: a spirit that is very human and I want to say, free. I say this because the members of the group feel free and are being freed up to feel and express some of the deepest human emotions. At this point, you might be thinking that I am only referring to the sorrow and sadness of grief, but I am not...I am also referring to joy and laughter.

I have been observing this for some time now and because someone in the group mentioned that they thought something was wrong or weird that they were experiencing both of those emotions sorrow and laughter in close proximity, to each other, (continued on page 2)

I remarked that it was not a sign of something being wrong with them, but more likely a sign that the depth of the cut they were experiencing in their grief had opened up their heart and ironically allowed them to experience other emotions more deeply, especially joy and laughter. It is reminiscent of Jesus' words about how the grief of the apostles after his death would be "turned into joy." A Benedictine monk, Herbert van Zeller, expressed it this way:

"So it is that in the Christian understanding, as fashioned by Christ himself, joy and pain and not exclusive but compatible. Indeed we come to know joy through suffering and suffering through joy. The deeper the one, the truer the other."

I would like to express my gratitude to former staff member, Daneen Warsinskey, who helped to get the group started as well as to Jean Herris who has taken on the role played by Daneen. Thanks also to Deacon John who also attends each meeting and played the role of "grill master" at the last meeting.

Finally, the goodness and spirit of the Grief Support Group planted in me another seed that may want germination and growth: a support group for people who have family members with LGBTQ issues. I know Fr. Johns has had such a group at St. John Vianney for many years, but it seems to me that this issue is becoming more and more of an issue and presents very complicated and deep questions and emotions that are very hard to navigate alone. And similar to the issue of grief, it is not often easy or possible to have these discussions, even with family members or close friends. 
