A Message from Father Mike

Brothers and Sisters,

Happy Advent! We are now already at the second of four Advent Sundays. There's a bit of irony in all of this. The Incarnation is the primary moment in our lives as believers and we take only four weeks to prepare for this event. Seems a little brief, doesn't it? But, in reality, it's probably not. We try as best we can to appropriate all those things that are necessary for us to engage in this preparatory time. By that I mean that our lives as believers are in reality an opening of ourselves up to the holy and awesome mystery of God.

So, I think the real clue here is that we take advantage of this privileged time in the Church year to remind ourselves of that horizon to which we always look: God. And as we do so we allow all of the Advent images that Sacred Scripture gives us to become part of our awareness of how we have a share in God's own life.

The Sacred books are a means of privileged access to God. There are stories of God's mighty deeds, of hopes and horizons, sin and redemption, compassion, mercy, and peace. That's why the Bible is so important to us.

As a means of observing Advent, may I remind us all to bring our Bibles to Church: not Give Us This day, not Magnificat, not the hymnals with the readings, but The Holy Bible. This is the book of the Church, and I think we ought to take a lesson from our Protestant sisters and brothers who bring their Bibles with them. The holy books need to become a part of us and who we are, just as we ought to make the same thing of Eucharist. The readings for the following Sunday are published in the bulletin for your use so you can prepare your Bibles.

So, remember..... BRING YOUR BIBLES TO CHURCH.
