
Today, in Owatonna, we will join Sacred Heart Parish following the 10:00 AM Mass for a procession of the Blessed Sacrament on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). The procession begins from Sacred Heart at the end of the 10:00 AM Mass there and will proceed west and then north onto S. Elm Avenue to our parish, where we will meet outside at the front of the church. We will continue the procession north on Elm, cross E. Main St. and go west on E. Main St. to Central Park, circle Central Park, and proceed back to St. Joseph Church via S. Cedar Ave. to School St. and to the front of the church on S. Elm. Benediction inside the church will conclude the procession. Songs and prayers along the way. Everyone is welcome to join in this moment of grace for our local Catholic community.


