

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Weather permitting, the contractor will finish up the trusses and start blocking (reinforcing) the roof. Senegal will start sealing the parking lot. Also, weather permitting, expect to see paving of the parking lot to the east side of the church. On the lower level, our electrician will be running wires in the walls (roughing). Finally, Mahoney Fire Sprinklers Inc will start to install the fire sprinkler system.

Our subcontract of the week is Mahoney Fire Sprinkler, Inc. Founder Bob Mahoney, now retired, began independent operations in Nebraska and Iowa in 1999. Mahoney Fire Sprinkler performs services throughout the entire state of Nebraska and western Iowa. Services offered include new sprinkler installation, modification, design, repairs, inspections, backflow testing, and 24 hour service. Their motto is "We put out fires everywhere."

## Box Tops for Education is going digital!

- They are transitioning from clipping to a digital-only program
- In order to participate in the digital-only program, you must download the Box Top mobile app (you can get it on Google Play or the App Store)
- Once you have the app downloaded and all set up you simply scan your \*receipt and the app will find participating products and add them to St. Matthew's earnings online (\*receipts must be scanned within 14 days of purchase)
- Earnings are automatically updated online so you can see the school's earnings for the year
- If you prefer, you can send in your receipts and our Box Top Coordinator will scan them for you
- Any products you purchase/have purchased that still have Box Tops on them will be honored-so keep clipping and turning those in the traditional way
