- ---Enjoy quick access to current community updates, bulletins, ministry schedules, Faith Direct giving, daily readings, new church updates and much, much more!
- ---You can also select to receive notifications from the parish or specific parish groups! To receive notifications, select 'Allow' when prompted while downloading the app. If you wish to do this at a later date, you may do this in your phone's settings (instruction links are available on our website, as well).

--Note: You must have notifications turned on in your phone's settings <u>and</u> the app, to receive instant notifications.

# HOW TO RECEIVE INSTANT NOTIFICATIONS FROM SELECT PARISH GROUPS:

If you'd like to receive instant notifications from the parish office, or specific groups follow these steps in our parish app:

- 1. Open your app.
- 2. Click on 'More' in the bottom right corner.
- 3. Click on 'Message Settings'.
- 4. Click each group you wish to receive messages from. (Green means you will receive instant messages from that group.)

Groups that you may elect to receive messages from are: Religious Ed, Set-up/Take Down, Special Events, PTO, Security Team, Knights, Extra Help, Daily Mass, Prayer Warriors and General (Parish Office Notifications). Note: These are groups subject to change.

Please also check for updates in the app store/google play to ensure best performance.
