CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Unfortunately, the weather has not been cooperating but we are still making progress. The foundation has been poured and the walls have started to go up on the east side of the building (which is hard to see from 36th St). The elevator shaft has been started and underground utilities are being run. We expect the first pour in the east wall to begin this week. The Building Steering Committee visited the studios of Michael Montag this past week. He is the artist who is creating our bronze Sanctuary Corpus and Stations of the Cross. He is making great progress as can be viewed in the video updates in the commons. His work to date has been all in wax from which he will make the mold in which the bronze will be poured.

SANCTUARY STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

In the new church, there will be six 14' stained glass windows, three on each side. We plan to put Saints in those windows. We are asking help from the parish to identify candidates for this creation. So, if you have a favorite Saint you would like us to look at, submit the name and a few facts about the individual for our consideration to the parish office. We plan to narrow the selection to about ten Saints and hold a parish vote to select the six Saints who will adorn our new church.



... after the phone call you hoped you'd never get.

 ... after the funeral, when everyone has left and the emotions you've held at bay come crashing in on you.

... after the relationship falls apart and the bottom falls out of your life.

. . . after the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing more we can do."

... after the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, "Welcome to your new home."

. . . after the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away—and the house suddenly seems empty.

. . . after the gavel comes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away.

... after the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible.

... after you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.

... after your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the After People. They are ready to come alongside you—or your friends, neighbors, coworkers, or relatives—and provide comfort and support for as long after as needed.
