

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

We should see shingles any day now and it will take about two weeks to complete. After the shingles and EIFS are complete the outside of the building will be pretty much finished.

The brick is complete on the outside of the building with the exception of some work on the east side entrance. The contractor has made significant progress on the application of the EIFS (Exterior Insulation and Finish System) to the remainder of the exterior of the building.

On the upper level, drywall continues. Ducting is pretty much complete. All major pieces of equipment for the heating and air conditioning systems are in place.

On the lower level, the Parish Offices have been painted. The restrooms have been tiled. The contractor is currently installing the grid for the false ceiling. Completion date remains 11 September.



ANNUAL APPEAL VS CAPITAL CAMPAIGN WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

It will soon be time for our Annual Appeal. Further, this year we will have a Capital Campaign in the Fall. So what's the difference and why two different events?

The Annual Appeal, as the name implies, occurs every year. At St Matthew we have selected Lent, a time of prayer, abstinence and almsgiving, as the time for our Annual Appeal. The pledges made during the Annual Appeal address our day-to-day, week-to-week financial needs, our operating fund. Also this year, we will include an opportunity for parishioners to renew/start their ministry commitments (Usher, Greeter, EME, Server, etc). The Appeal will include a short presentation on the Parish Financial situation during masses at a date to be announced. Then parishioners will receive a pledge card in the mail to make their pledges (time, talent & treasure) for FY 2020 — 2021 (July 2020 to June 2021). Commitment Sunday will be announced at a later time.

The <u>Capital Campaign</u> typically occurs about once every three years. Our last Capital Campaign held in 2017 (Upon this Rock) resulted in \$2.3M in pledges and allowed us to start building our new Sanctuary which will complete in September. These pledges run out on December 31, 2020, so we need to have a new set of capital pledges in place to cover the mortgage and address other capital improvements to the campus.

The reason we have two events (Annual Appeal & Capital Campaign) is to assure the parishioner their pledge is being used for what they intend. If the parishioner is more inclined to contribute to a major capital project, like a new building, then a larger pledge in the Capital Campaign would make sense. If you are more concerned about paying our monthly bills then a larger pledge to the Annual Appeal is in order. Pledges to the Annual Appeal and Capital Campaign are tracked and a regular status provided to the parishioner.

We have received permission from the Archdiocese to gather for Mass with some guidelines.

Mass Times: Tues - Fri @ 9am, Saturday 5pm, Sunday 10:30am. All masses in the gym.

The dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation remains in force. Live streaming of Masses will continue.

People who should not attend:

- a. People with COVID-19 or live with someone with COVID-19
- b. People who have been exposed to someone with COVID-19
- c. Elderly
- d. People with underlying medical conditions
- e. Family members who live with elderly people or those who are at risk
- f. People who have access to those at risk in nursing homes
- g. People who have upper respiratory or flu-like symptoms
- h. People who live with someone with upper respiratory or flue like symptoms

If you plan to attend mass in person, please note the following guidelines and information:

--IT IS MANDATORY TO WEAR A MASK.

- --Practice social distancing while entering and exiting church.

 Families should remain 6 feet apart from other people.
- --Use only marked entrances.
- --No socializing or fellowship is permitted in the building or on sidewalk areas.
- --Parishioners are strongly encouraged to wear masks.
- -- There will be no choirs at Mass.
- --Holy water will be available to take home, bring your own container.
- --Communion will be distributed only in the hand. Everyone will be given hand sanitizer just before receiving.
- --Chairs will be set up at recommended distances. Various group settings will be available.

 Ushers will assist with seating. Set up must remain the same. Do not move chairs.
- --Seating is limited and some may be turned away.
- -- Restroom facilities will be limited.
- --Collection baskets will be staged at the exit.
- --Sign up genius will be sent out for limited ministries, i.e EME, Lectors, Ushers. (No altar servers)
- --All chairs will be disinfected before and after masses.
- --If attending daily mass, please sit in the designated area.
- --We will email all updates to these guidelines. They are available on our website.
- --All other campus events are still suspended.
