St. Teresa of Calcutta said ""Prayer makes your heart bigger, until it is capable of containing the gift of God himself. Prayer begets faith, faith begets love, and love begets service on behalf of the poor." Come to this year's FBC sessions for opportunities for yourself, and your family, to grow more deeply in love with God through prayer. We will be following COVID-19 safety guidelines for the youth and adult sessions.

What are the Circle of Care, Circle of Grace and Safe **Environment Programs?** The Circle of Care program is an umbrella program that assists in our parish's and archdiocese's efforts to best protect our parish and school youth, as well as other vulnerable individuals, from unsafe adult-youth interactions. The Circle of Care program has two components—the Circle of Grace (CoG) teaching program for our youth and the Safe Environment (SE) certification program for our adults. Our youth receive Circle of Grace teachings in their School or Religious Education classes. Adults receive Safe Environment training in either a face-to-face training session (Initial Training) or via online training (Recertification Training). In addition to training, a Safe Environment certified adult must also submit to, and successfully pass, a recurring background check. FOUNDATION FAMILIES


