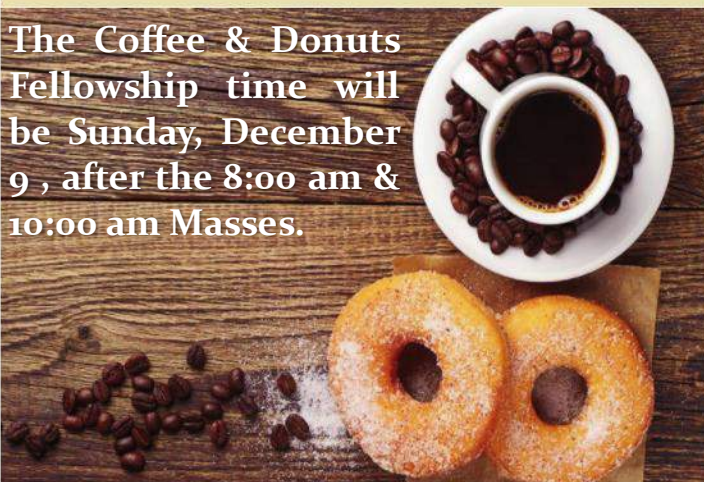

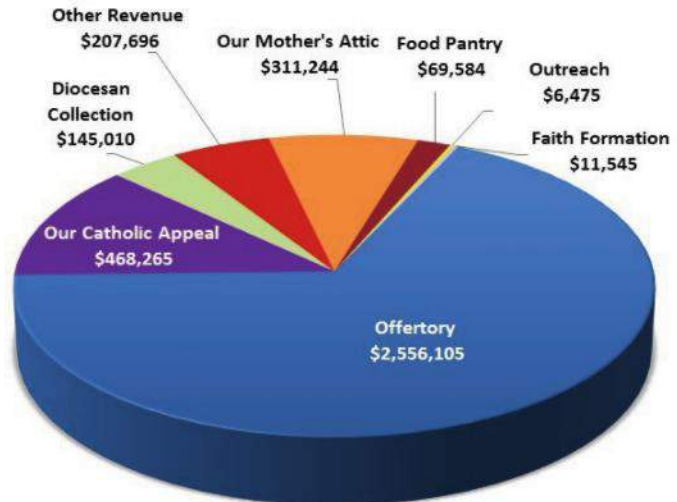

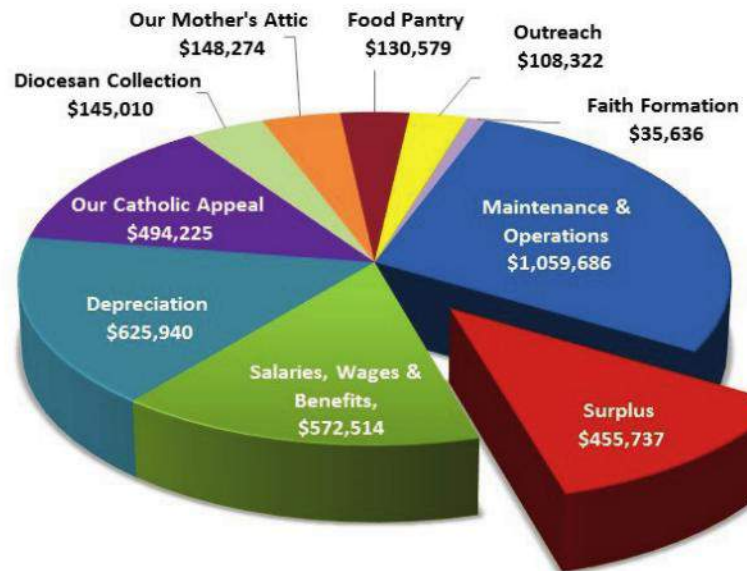
Parish Fiscal Year
