It was part of the Blessed Mother's Altar in that church. Just recently it has been very skillfully painted and gilded by the artist working in our church. #### **Special Advent Masses**




ioners and faithful Giving Tree supporters, this Christmas 2019 we will continue doing the same as we did last
