Health Ministry: Contacts and Allergies

Pollen count up... eyes itchy and irritated.



Wearing contact lenses? Want relief? Reach for an antihistamine... NOT! This medication causes dry eyes which can make lenses uncomfortable and can increase the risk of an eye infection.

There are other possible causes of dry eyes, including alcohol, decongestants, diuretics, birth control pills, air travel, smoke and sprays, and chemical disinfectants.

Possible solutions:

- Switch back to glasses when eyes are most irritated.
- Wear contacts for shorter periods of time.
- Eye drops? In general, over the counter (OTC) eye drops should *not* be placed in the eye while wearing contacts. The only exception is for medications specifically made to be used while wearing contact lenses. Products not labeled safe to use with contacts may contain preservatives or chemicals that can damage the contacts.
 - Try the single-use contact lenses.

Introductions to Sunday Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



First Reading - Acts 1:1-11

Today's passage takes us back to the beginning verses of the Acts of the Apostles and sets forth the themes that Luke is going to develop throughout this, the longest book of the New Testament. His major theme is the role of the Holy Spirit, who enables the apostles to be effective witnesses to Jesus. (The Holy Spirit is mentioned 57 times in the Acts of the Apostles.)

Second Reading - Ephesians 1:17-23

Ephesus was an ancient city located on the western coast of what is today Turkey. Paul visited there several times. Today's passage, which is near the beginning of the letter to the Ephesians, is a prayer asking God's blessings upon that community. Many thoughts in this prayer are connected to today's feast of the Ascension.


