

Answers to the FIRST EUCHARIST Faith Quiz

- (d) Catholics pray in front of the tabernacle in recognition of Christ's presence there. Consecrated hosts from the tabernacle are brought to the sick and homebound who cannot attend Mass.
- 2. (a) Blessed Imelda had such a deep love for Christ in the Eucharist that the consecrated host appeared over her when she prayed in front of the tabernacle.
- 3. (b) Christ is the word made flesh that is given to us through his teachings in the Scriptures as well as in the sacraments.
