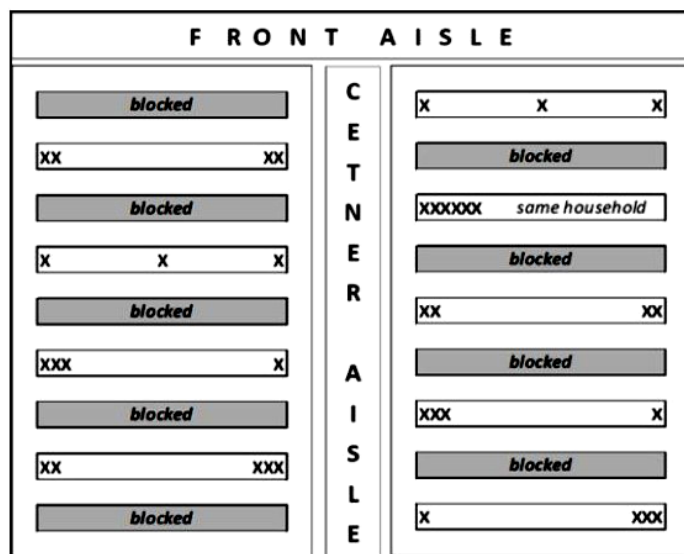

## Health Ministry:

### Alzheimer's Disease

### 6 Million Americans Suffer!

This memory-robbing disease was named after Dr. Alzheimer, who detailed in handwriting the description of the disease in 1901. It is expected to grow significantly as the US population grows and ages. Possible causes with age being the strongest risk, followed by: family history, high blood pressure, heart disease, head trauma, diabetes, stroke and increased cholesterol. Tried treatments: Lose weight, quit smoking, get enough sleep, physical activity, nutritious diet, stay socially active, brain games, read, write, and various medications treating diabetes and high blood pressure. Disappointing news: There is not convincing evidence that any of the treatments work. But there is a good chance that what is good for your overall health is good for your cognitive health. Cognition: awareness with perception, reasoning, intuition and memory. One conclusion - physical activity may be effective in preventing cognitive decline if it is started early and is sustained, but adding physical activity later in life may be less beneficial. *WE REMEMBER THEIR LOVE WHEN THEY CAN NO LONGER REMEMBER.* Psychology Today/Oxford Academic/Quote

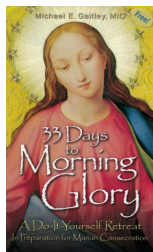

## Introductions to Sunday Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



### **First Reading - Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48**

Peter was originally skeptical about preaching the Gospel to non-Jews. Then one day, the Holy Spirit summoned him to preach to the pagan army officer Cornelius and his household. The result, as we shall see, is the first recorded conversion of Gentiles to Christianity.

### **Second Reading - 1 John 4:7-10**

The tradition of the apostle John's teachings is expressed in what is called the first letter of John. There is a legend that John in his old age would simply repeat over and over and over to his people, "Love one another." Today's passage from that letter particularly illustrates this story.

## Readings for Saturday and Sunday

### First Reading - Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48

When Peter entered, Cornelius met him and, falling at his feet, paid him homage. Peter, however, raised him up, saying, "Get up. I myself am also a human being." Then Peter proceeded to speak and said, "In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him." While Peter was still speaking these things, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the word. The circumcised believers who had accompanied Peter were astounded that the gift of the Holy Spirit should have been poured out on the Gentiles also, for they could hear them speaking in tongues and glorifying God. Then Peter responded, "Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people, who have received the Holy Spirit even as we have?" He ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.

### Second Reading - 1 John 4:7-10

Beloved, let us love one another, because love is of God; everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God. Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love. In this way the love of God was revealed to us: God sent his only Son into the world so that we might have life through him. In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins.
