## Health Ministry:

**Fall - the Beautiful Season.**

**Falls - the Unfortunate Action.**



Falling is the second leading cause of *accidental* death world wide and a major cause of injury, especially for the elderly. One in three adults, 65 years or older, falls each year. Even if there is no injury, one is often left with the fear of falling again, which cuts down on everyday activities causing one to become weaker, which increases the chance of falling again.

## Conditions that contribute to falling:

Lower body weakness, vitamin D deficiency, difficulty walking, some medications, vision problems, foot pain or poor footwear, and home hazards. Most falls occur in: bathroom (36%), bedroom (21%), kitchen (15%), and living room (6%). **Fall prevention:**

- \* Talk with your doctor to evaluate your risk.
- \* Do strength and balance exercises.
- \* Have your vision checked regularly.
- \* Make your home safer...increase light, get rid of clutter and rugs, install grab rails in bathrooms, place railings on both sides of stairs and avoid walking around your house wearing socks or slippery house shoes. CDC/Medscape/Hearthsides

## Introductions to Sunday Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



### First Reading - Isaiah 53:10-11

Our first Scripture reading contains the message of a prophet who spoke to the Jewish people during their exile in Babylon. In four different places, this prophet speaks about a "Servant of God" who will one day deliver God's people and make them great again. Because the Servant is frequently portrayed as suffering, Christians have applied this to Jesus.

Today's reading is a small portion from the last and longest of these four passages.

*(On Good Friday we read the entire passage.)*

### Second Reading - Hebrews 4:14-16

The Jewish high priest was responsible for entering the holiest place in the Jerusalem temple to make sin offerings on behalf of the people. Several times, the Letter to the Hebrews emphasizes that Jesus is superior to any high priest because he has entered the *heavenly* temple, and thus has given us access to God's "Throne of Grace."

3. (d) "Lying is the most direct offense against the truth. To lie is to speak or act against the truth in order to lead someone into error. The Lord denounces lying as the work of the devil."
4. (c) The Old Testament tells the story of the Jewish people from the creation of the world until the years before the birth of Christ.
5. (a) For the Israelite, the Ark of the Covenant carried the evidence that God was with them. Besides the tablets, the Ark contained manna from the desert and Aaron's staff (see Hebrews 9:4; cf. CCC, 2058).
6. (a) The Ten Commandments gave the Israelites concrete guidelines on how to live as God's chosen people.
