From the desk of the Administrator

Of great importance this week is that I share with you that the "Consistent Ethic of Life" session has been scheduled for March 5, 2019 at 7:15 PM at St. Bonaventure in Newmeyer Hall. We will welcome nationally known speaker and fellow Pittsburgher, Aimee Murphy. All are welcome to attend.

In today's bulletin is a schedule for the Lenten Season that is just around the corner! Can you believe that?

I do want to bring your attention to a couple of things. They include the following:

Ash Wednesday. I felt it important that everyone have access to at least one Mass, with the regularly scheduled Wednesday Masses at SNP and ASP. I'm guessing these five Masses and three services are sufficient.

Stations of the Cross. For a few years now, Millvale has had early and late Stations. Given the ages of our congregations, that's probably not a bad idea. While I'd like to see only two stations per week, it seems that we are not quite ready to scale that far back this year. Notice how they do rotate.

Confessions. Reminding people of the regular schedule is always a good idea. I must confess that we had a bit of a failed "Light On" in Advent. Therefore, each parish will have it, with three (3) Priests at Bonaventure. Millvale has a tradition of a Penance Service, which is at the end of the season. All five (5) Priests will be there. I had the idea for Advent to do an early "Light On" for any elderly. So, there's no joking about three hours of confession on 4/1! The other times are following the regularly scheduled daily Masses in preparation for Holy Week.

Anointing of the Sick. Both Millvale and Etna have regularly scheduled Anointings in the spring. Millvale's will be in the evening with Mass. Etna's will be after the 11:30 Mass, with a service. I ask you to RSVP so that the reception folks can plan appropriately.

Sacred Triduum. While I had hope for one celebration each day, I feel we are not quite ready to do that. However, we can start to move in that direction. Therefore, we are keeping three Thursdays, three Fridays, but only one Easter Vigil, at SBP.

Easter Sunday. We all know the popularity of this day. Therefore, we will keep our usual Sunday schedule but add two Masses, a 10:05 at SBP in Newmeyer Hall and a 12:30 PM.

At one point or another, we have all heard the "Golden Rule": *do unto others as you would have them do unto you.* Jesus is the one

stating the Golden Rule in today's Gospel reading from Luke, however this basic ethical doctrine can be found in almost every major religious tradition around the world. It seems simple enough to follow this rule, and nearly everyone seems to agree in principle that we should, but Jesus points out in the Gospel the many times when it is difficult to do so. As followers of Jesus, we are called to love our enemies as well as our friends. We are called to bless those who curse us, and pray for those who mistreat us. We are called to lend even when there is no expectation of being repaid. None of these things are easy for us to do, but all of them are essential for us to truly be followers of Jesus. As we draw nearer to Lent, a time when we reflect on the ways we sometimes fail to be the disciples of Christ we should be, perhaps we should all ask God to heighten our ability to treat others lovingly when it is not easy to do so. That will go a long way towards making us the disciples we need to become. Something to consider as you reflect upon what you prayed and sang at Mass this weekend.
