SAINT OF THE WEEK

NATIVITY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST

First Century - Solemnity—June 24



In the Gospels, John, a kinsman of Jesus through their mothers, preached repentance and baptized with water to prepare for the Messiah's coming. This feast marks his exceptional birth to the aged priest, Zechariah, and the equally aged and barren Elizabeth. The angel Gabriel announces his birth in a vision to Zechariah, who hesitates in believing and is struck mute until eight days after John's birth. Then, Zechariah, in a beautiful canticle that ends the first chapter of Luke's Gospel, proclaims that John "will be called prophet of the Most High" (Lk 1:76). John's eventual beheading is commemorated with an Aug. 29 feast. A patron saint of Canada and Jordan, John is also the patron of Florence and the Knights Hospitaller of St. John.

Stewardship

God uses money as a testimony
in the lives of His people.

"But seek first the kingdom (of God) and his righteousness, and all these things will be given you besides" (Matt. 6:33).

Applying Bible Principles

"... whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come" (2 Cor. 5:17). Christians should have a different outlook on life, including money and material possessions. They realize that they own nothing, that everything they have belongs to God, and that they are only managers and stewards of what God has entrusted to them. Because of that, Christians should have a different attitude towards "things."

That attitude demonstrates itself in many different ways. For example, Christians show mercy and give, in contrast to those who borrow and do not repay (Psalm 37:21). Christians should hold possessions with an open hand, and "refresh" others with their bounty (Proverbs 11:24-25). They are honest and demonstrate their faith by their work and integrity (1 Thes. 4:11-12). They give to those in need and thereby demonstrate to a watching world the love of God (1 John 3:17).

When this kind of lifestyle is present in our lives, Jesus said that people will see our good works — our different attitude and perspective — and will glorify our heavenly Father (Matt. 5:16). And as we seek His kingdom first and foremost, we have His promise that He will provide what we need (Matt. 6:33).

As others observe you and your lifestyle, do they see any difference because of your faith in the Lord Jesus Christ? As they observe your relationship to "things," especially to money, do they realize you are a manager, a steward, and not an owner? Or stated another way, is the manner in which you handle money and material possessions a testimony to your faith in Christ?

Aplicación de los Principios de la Biblia

"... Quien está en Cristo es una nueva creación: las cosas viejas pasaron; observar, aquí, vienen cosas nuevas" (2 Cor. 5:17). Los cristianos deben tener una perspectiva diferente en la vida, incluyendo dinero y posesiones materiales. Se dan cuenta de que no poseen nada, que todo lo que tengan pertenece a Dios, y que son sólo administradores y mayordomos de lo que Dios ha confiado a ellos. Por eso, los cristianos deben tener una actitud diferente hacia "cosas".

Esa actitud demuestra muchas maneras diferentes. Por ejemplo, los cristianos muestran misericordia y dar, en contraste con aquellos que pedir prestado y no pagar (Salmo 37:21). Los cristianos deben mantener las posesiones con la mano abierta, y "refrescar" a otros con su generosidad (Proverbios 11: 24-25). Son honestos y demuestran su fe por su trabajo e integridad (1 Tes. 4: 11-12). Ellos dan a los necesitados y con ello demostrar a un mundo que observa el amor de Dios (1 Juan 3:17).

Cuando este tipo de estilo de vida está presente en nuestras vidas, Jesús dijo que la gente verá nuestras buenas obras, nuestra perspectiva y actitud diferente y glorificar a nuestro Padre celestial (Mateo 5:16). Y mientras buscamos primero su reino, tenemos su promesa que él proveerá lo que necesitamos (Mateo 6:33).

Mientras otros observan tú y tu estilo de vida, ¿ven alguna diferencia a causa de su fe en el Señor Jesucristo? Como observa su relación con "cosas", especialmente de dinero, ¿se dan cuenta que usted es un gerente, un administrador y no dueño? ¿O indicado de otra manera, es la manera en que manejas dinero, posesiones materiales un testimonio de su fe en Cristo?

12th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
FAITH: GOD AMID THE STORMS

There is a timely message in the readings today! Whether it is God addressing Job amid the storms and difficulties in his life, or Jesus calming the storm that is overwhelming the boats of the disciples, there is a challenge to the faith of the listeners. They, and we, are assured that, indeed, God is in charge here. At the time this Gospel was written, the young Church led by the apostles was being persecuted. The powerful symbol of the storm being calmed by the word and power of Jesus would be a reminder to the fear-filled disciples that the Holy Spirit was given to them, that the Lord was still with them. They would remember that Jesus could both calm the seas and have power over evil just as he had healed the possessed during his earthly ministry.

That is a key message for us as well. There are times and circumstances that may make it seem less easy to depend on God, but, as St. Paul tells us through his letter to the Corinthians, because Jesus has risen, we have hope. The love of Christ for all God's people gives us hope, and that same love impels us – urges us most strongly -- to believe and to witness to the power of God in and through Jesus.

This is the same faith and power that we must have in our own lives, to face and grapple with the difficulties in our lives. We do not confront these alone. Jesus assures us that He will always be with us, and that the Father has sent the Holy Spirit to be our guide and strength, our advocate in times of trouble, as well as in time of joy and peace. We are empowered by our faith and the grace of God to hope, to know that there is some good that needs to be drawn from each storm in our lives. That is God's promise. That is why our life's journey is a journey of growing in faith. May you and each of us be strengthened by God's grace! May we always remember – and sometimes help one another remember – that our God of love, mercy and peace is always with us.
