A WORD FROM FR. ANDREW

My dear parishioners and friends,

I am truly moved with pity for those who can't stand their job. Those who feel out of place in the workplace. Those who can't stand the sight of their boss or perhaps even their coworkers. Those who are extremely unhappy with the kind of work they do. Those who feel bored and unfulfilled. It really must be a terrible existence to get up every day of your life feeling as if you must drag yourself to work. There are far too many people who feel just this way. You may know them. I hear their stories on a regular basis.

Labor Day gives me pause to reflect upon my own job and just what it is that I do. The hours aren't the greatest. The pay isn't too good either. It provides housing but I have lived in bigger houses and more exciting places. "The black uniform, although slenderizing for some, makes me feel funereal and boring." In my line of work you're lucky if you have a good Bishop (as we do) for a boss, but you also realize that there are others in the hierarchy to whom you must answer as well. The chain of bosses doesn't end there and many times includes the thousands of souls who are entrusted to your care. Yes, it is a company filled with bosses! It's a job where you're always held under a microscope and of late has received the most horrendous of press. Sounds like a pretty lousy job.

And yet I wonder why it is that I feel so fulfilled in my ministry. To be able to be with people at the most intimate moments of their lives both joyful and sometimes heart wrenching. To be able to lead others to God through praise and worship. To experience the miracle at your fingers every time you share the Eucharist with another human being. To touch hearts of young and old alike with mere words. I wonder why it is that on most mornings I awake excited about what lies ahead on any given day? I wonder what it is that makes my job so different then so many others?

And yes, I know that my job is not just a job, but it is indeed a vocation. But whatever it is or however you look at it, I thank God every day of my life for the priesthood that he has given me during these last 34 years and most especially during the last 2 in which I have served as your pastor. I am grateful for the job that I have, and I pray wholeheartedly for those who have not found the same kind of peace, happiness or fulfillment in their own walks of life. I pray that I may be able to journey with them and I invite others to journey with me on the path I have taken. I pray for those who are undecided or those who cannot find work. I pray for those who are unable to work. But above all, I give praise and glory to God for the work that he has given me to do in this wonderful job and vocation of mine! Thank you for letting me work with you!
