

THIS IS US

This Is Us; yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

This weekend the Knights of Columbus are speaking at all the Masses to share a brief explanation of who they are and to invite the men of our parish to consider joining the Knights. As you perhaps know, or will learn this weekend, the Knights of Columbus are a fraternal group of Catholic men. They were founded by Blessed Michael McGivney, a priest of the Archdiocese of Hartford who grew up in Waterbury and while serving as priest at St. Mary parish in New Haven, founded the Knights of Columbus, which is now a worldwide Catholic fraternity whose headquarters is located in New Haven.

When Blessed Michael McGivney was alive, he died in 1890, the Catholic population in Connecticut was increasing dramatically as large numbers of Catholics, mostly from Europe, were pouring into the United States. What had been few Catholics and few priests in our state was becoming many Catholics and increasing numbers of priests just as now the opposite is occurring. This reality was brought home to me at the recent convocation of priests that took place earlier this month. As you can see below, we lost a large number of priests over the past several years; some were very elderly but a number were active, serving as pastors in several parishes. This weekend a relic of Blessed Michael McGivney will be reserved in the daily Mass Chapel at Sacred Heart Church. Let us ask Blessed



Michael McGivney to pray that God will bless our Church of tomorrow with many religious vocations, faith-filled staff and volunteers and pews filled with the faithful all joining to praise our loving God.

You are invited to stop in before or after Mass to pray before and reverence the relic. In celebration of All Saints Day, relics of several saints will be available to pray before at both our Churches the following times:

Seeds of Hope for Haiti Once again, Seeds of Hope for Haiti is unable to host our annual Gala in October. Like 2020, we will conduct a fall fundraiser to support our Haitian sisters and brothers in Grand Boulage. The Covid-19 Pandemic continues to impact our lives and schedules so significantly that we have decided not to hold a physical event this year to keep our community safe. But the tremendous need for your generous support remains. Disasters, natural and man-made, continue to plague Haiti. The country is still recovering from the recent earthquake and tropical storm. These disasters damaged crops and food processing and distribution centers resulting in food shortages throughout the country, including Grand Boulage. Vaccines and therapeutics to fight the COVID-19 pandemic in Haiti remain scarce. Haiti's ongoing political strife, including the assassination of its president, coupled with gruesome gang violence, make even routine travel and daily life dangerous. So, the situation is dire. Your contribution,

no amount being too small, will educate and feed 450 children each day and provide health care for almost 10,000 villagers in Grand Boulage.
