The Ladies Guild is having a Thanksgiving raffle. The drawing will be on November 17th. We are asking for donations of items to put in the baskets which will have different themes:

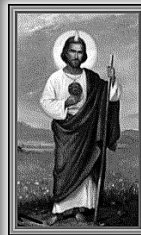

## WORDS OF WISDOM

The spirit of wisdom, as we discover in today's first reading, comes to those who pray for her. Wisdom, like the word of God, carries a message of consolation as well as of great challenge. The Letter to the Hebrews tells us that the word of God, infused with the wisdom of God, is "sharper than any two-edged sword." We cannot shrink from the wisdom of God, or from the word that has the power to penetrate our hearts and minds. Jesus, the living word of God, the embodiment of wisdom, has strong, deeply penetrating words for the rich young man who comes to him seeking answers to his most profound questions. Just when the young man thought he had done enough to fulfill God's commands, more was asked of him. This is no less true for us.

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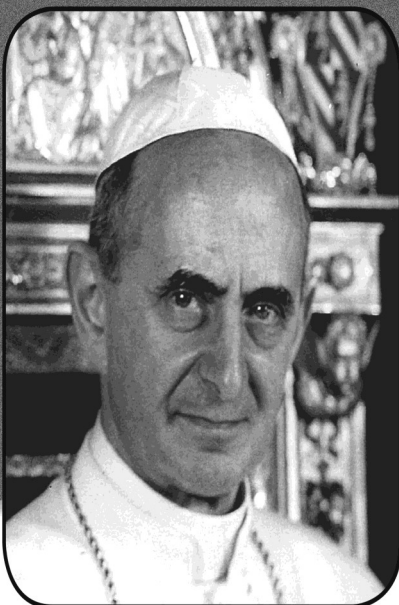


## PALABRAS DE SABIDURÍA

Hoy aprendemos en la primera lectura que el Espíritu de la sabiduría llega a los que lo invocan. La sabiduría, como la Palabra de Dios, lleva un mensaje de consuelo y a la vez constituye un gran desafío. La carta a los hebreos nos cuenta que la Palabra de Dios, que está empapada con la sabiduría de Dios, es "más penetrante que una espada de dos filos". No podemos acobardarnos ante la sabiduría de Dios ni ante la palabra que tiene el poder de penetrar nuestro corazón y mente. Jesús, la Palabra viva de Dios, la encarnación de la sabiduría, le dice cosas fuertes y muy penetrantes al joven rico que acude a Jesús en busca de respuestas a sus dudas más profundas. Precisamente, cuando el joven pensaba que había hecho lo suficiente para cumplir los mandamientos de Dios, se le exigió más. Lo mismo sucede en nuestro caso.

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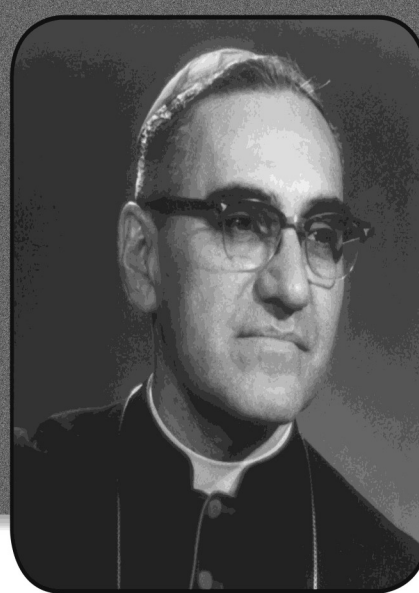
POPE SAINT PAUL VI



Giovanni Battista Montini was born near Brescia in northern Italy on September 26, 1897, the second of three sons. After his ordination in 1920, he engaged in graduate studies in literature, philosophy, and canon law in Rome before joining the Vatican Secretariat of State in 1924, where he worked for thirty years. In 1954, Father Montini was named archbishop of Milan, and became the first of twenty-three cardinals named by Pope John XXIII in 1958. Cardinal Montini assisted in the preparations for the Second Vatican Council and participated in its first sessions. After the death of Pope John XXIII in 1963, Cardinal Montini was elected to the Chair of Peter, taking the name Paul VI. He immediately decided to continue the Second Vatican Council, which convened for another three sessions before its conclusion on December 8, 1965. In addition to working as a tireless advocate for the promulgation of the reforms of Vatican II, Saint Paul VI promoted the cause of social justice as integral to Church teaching and advanced ecumenical and interfaith dialog significantly. He wrote seven papal encyclicals, including *Humanae Vitae*, which expounded on the value and dignity of human life and, more controversially, reaffirmed the Church's ban on artificial contraception. He greatly expanded and internationalized the College of Cardinals, set the maximum age at which a cardinal could vote in a papal conclave at 80, and established the retirement age for bishops at 75. Pope Paul VI died on August 6, 1978. He was beatified by Pope Francis on October 19, 2014, and canonized on October 14, 2018.

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SAINT ÓSCAR ROMERO



Óscar Arnulfo Romero y Galdámez was born into a large family on August 15, 1917 in the small town of Ciudad Barrios, El Salvador. He entered the seminary at the age of fourteen and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of San Salvador in 1942. Recognizing the power of radio to reach the people, he convinced five radio stations in San Miguel to broadcast his Sunday sermons to peasant farmers who believed they were unwelcome in the churches. In 1966 he became secretary to the El Salvador Episcopal Conference. In 1970 he was named Auxiliary Bishop in San Salvador, but gained a reputation as a stubborn and reactionary prelate. A brief spell as Bishop of Santiago de María opened Romero's eyes as he reconnected to the misery and hardship of the *campesinos* and witnessed the murderous repression being suffered at the hands of the security forces. In February 1977 he was the surprising choice to be the new Archbishop of San Salvador. From his cathedral pulpit Archbishop Romero became the voice of the voiceless poor. He continued to use the radio broadcast of his Sunday homilies to tell people what was happening throughout the country, to talk about the role of the Church, and to offer his listeners hope. Soon the archbishop became the target of the Salvadoran government's anger. On March 24, 1980, he was gunned down by an unknown assassin while celebrating Mass in a small hospital chapel. Only moments before his death, Romero had spoken these prophetic words: "Those who surrender to the service of the poor through love of Christ will live like the grain of wheat that dies . . . The harvest comes because of the grain that dies." In 1997, Pope John Paul II bestowed upon Óscar Romero the title of "Servant of God." In February of 2015, Pope Francis declared Archbishop Romero a martyr. The Church formally beatified him on May 23, 2015, and he was canonized on October 14, 2018.
