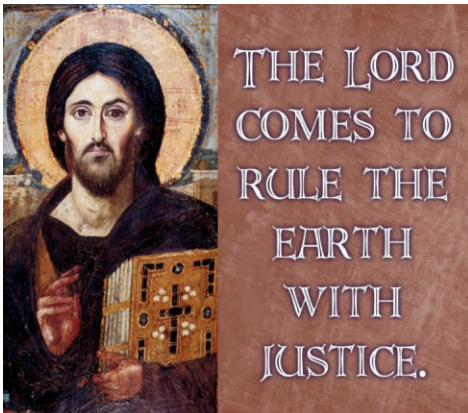

From Father Mike

The third pillar of the Uniting in Heart 2030 Pastoral Plan is giving witness to our faith, including our outreach to those in need around us. One opportunity coming up is the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD), the national anti-poverty program of the Catholic Bishops of the United States. It is the only official social outreach arm of the American Catholic Church. There are many national organizations where Catholics help the poor in this country, but this is the only one sponsored by all the U.S. bishops and funded through every diocese in this country. It is also focused on supporting programs that go beyond giving people money but are developing ways for people to be self-sustaining. This better use of donated monies also maintains a respect for the human worth of each person experiencing poverty. CCHD also uses a smarter and more systematic approach by partnering with communities to determine local solutions to empowering people to find employment, health, and education that will help them live a dignified life. Catholic Relief Services (CRS) does the same work except it operates in countries outside the U.S., and these are the two main branches of American Catholic charities that we are all asked to support each year. As we also gear up to support our local United Ministries Christmas Food Baskets and the Salvation Army Bell Ringing, and our parish outreach to Haiti with next weekend's Breakfast and Dessert Auction, we are blessed to be able to help those in need in our own community and across the world to continue the mission of Jesus care for the most vulnerable around us.

El tercer pilar del Plan Pastoral Uniting in Heart 2030 es dar testimonio de nuestra fe, incluyendo nuestro alcance a los necesitados que nos rodean. Una oportunidad que se presenta es la Campaña Católica para el Desarrollo Humano (CCHD), el programa nacional contra la pobreza de los Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos. Es el único brazo oficial de alcance social de la Iglesia Católica Americana. Hay muchas organizaciones nacionales donde los católicos ayudan a los pobres en este país, pero esta es la única patrocinada por todos los obispos de EE. UU. Y financiada a través de todas las diócesis de este país. También se centra en apoyar programas que van más allá de dar dinero a las personas, pero están desarrollando formas para que las personas sean autosuficientes. Este mejor uso del dinero donado también mantiene un respeto por el valor humano de cada persona que experimenta pobreza. CCHD también utiliza un enfoque más inteligente y sistemático al asociarse con las comunidades para determinar soluciones locales para empoderar a las personas a encontrar empleo, salud y educación que les ayudará a vivir una vida digna. Catholic Relief Services (CRS) hace el mismo trabajo, excepto que opera en países fuera de los EE. UU., Y estas son las dos ramas principales de las organizaciones benéficas católicas estadounidenses que todos debemos apoyar cada año. A medida que nos preparamos para apoyar nuestras canastas de alimentos navideñas locales del Ministerio de los Estados Unidos y las campanas de Salvation Army, y nuestro alcance parroquial a Haití con la subasta de desayuno y postres del próximo fin de semana, tenemos la bendición de poder ayudar a los necesitados en nuestra propia comunidad y en todo el mundo para continuar la misión de Jesús cuidar a los más vulnerables que nos rodean.

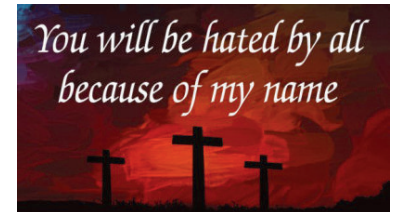
APLICACIONES DE LA CESTA DE ALIMENTOS DE NAVIDAD
