Ordained in 2002, Deacon Roger has served St. Brendan's in many capacities beyond his diaconate responsibilities. Active with HaitiReach, Family Promise, the Prison Ministry, Forsyth Ministers Association and the Food Pantry to name just a few, he was a tireless advocate for the vulnerable in our community.



Food Pantry Ministry Leader Barbara Gordon said, "I cannot remember a Christmas or Easter Market that Deacon Roger wasn't there serving Mac and Cheese to our families and, as needed, blessing our volunteers. However, more than anything, I appreciate our Deacon stepping up to help Pat in the food pantry. Even with our concern about the pandemic, he served. Most of all, I will miss Deacon Roger's sensitive homilies, his meaningful words from his heart. God bless you, Deacon Roger."



Cullen Larson, who made multiple trips to Haiti with Deacon Roger recalled his dedication and love for the people of Bassin-Zim saying, "Roger's commitment to living the Eucharist and to the people of Haiti strengthened both, and inspired his preaching and his heart for justice. The little kids practicing their English would call back and forth with Roger across the roadside cactus fence: 'I love you!' and 'I love you more!'. "

He also served on the Archdiocese of Atlanta's Diaconate Board.

Known for his "fist-bumping" greeting to children and adults as he left Mass, he and his wife Pat will remain active parishioners here at St. Brendan's.




